We execute CSRL Super 30 residential program at 19 locations in India & each year we help about 600 to 700 financially challenged students to get admission in IIT/NIT etc. One of our project at Srinagar which is sponsored by Petronet LNG, supports 45 students and help them build their career for themselves. Our program provides one year of completely free residential coaching and mentoring in life skills enabling them to face the toughest examination in engineering and secure a stable career.

Our overall success rate is 89%. In last 10 years we have transformed lives of more than 2889 students, out of which-791 has gone in A grade colleges like IITs e t c, 1770 has gone in B grade, which is NIT etc. and rest in C grade colleges.

So far almost 300 of these students are now very well placed in job which completes their transformation cycle.

We now wish to offer our services to the children/direct relatives (brothers, nephew, sister in law, brother in law and another) of martyr soldiers and also to the soldiers who were seriously wounded to bring a significant change in their lives. - C. Children/ direct relatives of wounded soldiers
- D. Children of humble paid employees like constable and one/two position above

2-The benefits under this program

- A. Free stay, food and normal health care etc
- B. Expert coaching in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics
- C. Regular tests, doubt classes etc
- D. Mentoring in personal hygiene, conduct and team work

3-Selection process and admission under this program

- A. Written test in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Aptitude
- B. in depth Interview by experts
- C. Verification of relevant records

4-Elibility for appearing at admission test

- A. Those students who are appearing at 12th Board
- B. Those class 11 students who will join class 12 this year
- C. Those who passed 12th last year (Only for NIT and state engineering colleges)

5-Location of the centre--preferably NOIDA

6-Period of coaching-25th June 2019 to End May 2020

7-Strength of the program-40 students of both gender
