NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 2019

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 18 of Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (66 of 1949), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Combatised Assistant Commandant (Official Language), Recruitment Rules, 2015 namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Reserve Police Force Combatised Assistant Commandant (Official Language), Group 'A' Post, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Reserve Police Force, Assistant Commandant (Official Language), Group 'A' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2015,-

(a) in rule 2 for the words "Pay Band and Grade Pay or Pay Scale" at both the places, the words "Level in the pay matrix" shall be substituted;

(b) in the Schedule ;

(i) against serial number 1 relating to the post of Assistant Commandant (Official Language),-

(A) for column (4) and the entries relating thereto the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Level in the Pay Matrix
(4)
Level-10 (Rs. 56100-177500)”;

(B) (i) in Note-1 below Column (11), for the word “Grade” at both the places, the word “Level in the Pay Matrix” shall be substituted.

(ii) the following Note-2 as per Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations below Column (11) may be omitted :-

“Note 2 : For the purpose of computing the minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> January , 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the six Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendation of the Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement.”
