U/C (.) Clarification regarding admissibility of provision of compensation for housing to PBORs of CAPFs attached with NDRF (.) Please refer to this Dte. (Estt Branch) order No. D.I-11/2019-Estt(D/Cell)-DA-II dated 19/03/2019 vide which it was conveyed that CRPF personnel selected for deputation to NDRF need to be imparted job training and other specialized training for a period of at least 02 years and this training period will be treated as attachment (.) On receipt of references, issue reg admissibility of HRA to CRPF personnel attached with NDRF for undergoing training before induction on deputation with NDRF under PBORs scheme has been examined in detail in consultation with FA (.) In order to avoid any audit observations at later stage, a proposal was mooted to MHA for issuing necessary clarification (.) Now, MHA vide its UO No. II-27012/09/2018/PF.I (Pt-I) (CF No. 3417032) dated 29/07/2019 has intimated that the matter has been examined in MHA in consultation with IFD and clarified that MHA OM No. II-27012/36/2010-PF.III dated 17/10/2013 (Copy enclosed), issued with the approval of DoE, MoF, is applicable to all organizations following the practice of Attachment / Temporary Transfer (.) In this connection this Dte letter No. T.IX-25/Inst-Min (HRA) dated 5/12/2013, 09/09/2014 and 21/10/2014 may also be referred to (.) Request take action accordingly///-

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Regarding Court Order dated 18.3.2013 pronounced in WP(C) 1731/2013 filed by Insp(M) Harvinder Singh, WP(C) 1733/2013 filed by SI(M) Suresh Kumar and WP(C) No.1734/2013 filed by SI/M Nekched Prasad before Hon'ble Delhi High Court for sanction of HRA/Transport Allowance for attachment period - entitlement of allowances while on attachment/ temporary transfer beyond 180 days.

The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi while considering grant of HRA, Transport allowance and all other admissible benefits while on attachment duties vide order dated 18.3.2013 in WP(C) 1731/2013 filed by Insp(M) Harvinder Singh, WP(C) 1733/2013 filed by SI(M) Suresh Kumar and WP(C) No.1734/2013 filed by SI/M Nekched Prasad (all belongs to CRPF), has also directed the respondents to ensure and create a mechanism which would verify such claims made and pass appropriate orders in a time bound manner preferably within eight weeks after receiving representations to avoid future litigations.

2 Accordingly, following mechanism has been framed to dispose of such claims during attachment/temporary transfer of officers/men with offices/ establishments other than their declared headquarters, at the rates as admissible at the place where they are on temporary transfer/attachment to avoid future litigations:-

- (i) Personnel on temporary transfer within 180 days will be entitled for DA as per provisions of SR-73.
- (ii) On further extension of temporary transfer period beyond 90 days, the place of temporary transfer may be declared as temporary headquarters under provisions of SR-59.
- (iii) On declaration of temporary headquarter personnel on temporary transfer will be eligible for HRA, Transport Allowance, etc.
- (iv) Such declaration of temporary headquarter will be done by Directorate General or concerned Head of Department as per existing instructions contained in FR/SRs.

3. The above provision will be effective prospectively from the date of issue of this order.

4. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Finance, Deptt. of Expenditure vide their I.D. No.2(20)/2011-E.II(B) dated 11.10.2013 and Integrated Finance Division of this Ministry vide their Dy. No. CF-321661/Fin.II/2013 dated 17.10.2013.


