U/C(.) Reg. admissibility of Tour TA/DA along with Risk Allowance (.) Please refer to your office Signal No. A.IX-3/2018-19-W/S-PC-II dated 22/02/2019 (.) In this connection, detailed instructions on the subject allowance already issued vide this Dte. letter No. A.I-78/Instn-Accts-3 dated 16/4/2010(.) However, issue regarding admissibility of tour TA along with RHA whenever CRPF person proceeds on tour has been examined once again in depth in consultation with Finance Branch (.) It is revealed that as per MHA Om No. II-27012/50/2008-PF-1 dated 16/4/2009 and OM No. II-27012/40/CF-3396706/2017-PF-1 dated 31/07/2017, CAPFs personnel deployed for Anti Naxal Operations in LWE/ Counter Insurgency operations in J&K and NE Areas shall have the option to draw their existing package of Compensatory allowance and detachment allowance, or the RHA whichever is beneficial (.) Further, as per Rule 46 of CRPF Rules 1955, CRPF personnel are entitled for drawal of detachment allowance in lieu of Tour TA up to 180 days under SR 73 and as such CRPF personnel are not eligible for drawal of RHA and Tour TA/DA simultaneously (.) In other words RHA is admissible up to 90 days only when CRPF personnel are away from their field unit for temporary duty (i.e. dak duty or special task assigned to officer for limited period) and tour TA up to 180 days only is admissible in terms of SR 73 when they are away from their place of duty for more than 90 days on temporary transfer/ attachment (.) Thus, clarification on the subject matter issued vide your signal under reference is not in order (.) Take action accordingly //-----
