NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. _____(E)___ In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 of the Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (66 of 1949), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' Combatised Veterinary Cadre (Group-A Posts) in the Central Reserve Police Force under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Central Reserve Police Force, Combatised Veterinary Cadre (Group 'A' posts), Recruitment Rules, 2023.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazettee.

2. Application

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix:-

The number of posts, their classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in column (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications etc:-**

The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Initial Constitution:-**

(i) Personnel holding the posts specified in the Column (1) of Schedule annexed herein, immediately before the commencement of these rules on the regular basis shall be deemed to have been appointed in accordance with the provisions of these rules.

(ii) The regular continuous service of personnel referred in sub-rule(1) in the respective grades immediately before the commencement of these rules shall count for the purpose of probation period, qualifying service for promotion, confirmation and pension in the service.

6. **Definitions :-**

In these rules, unless the contexts otherwise requires:-

- (1) “Cadre” means Veterinary Cadre (Group ‘A’) constituted under Rules.
- (2) “Government” means the Government of India.
- (3) “Level” means level of the pay matrix
- (4) “Scheduled Caste” and “Scheduled Tribes” shall have the same meanings as assigned to them respectively in clauses(24) and (25) of Article of the Constitution’ of India.

7. **Probation:-**

Every person appointed to the cadre in the level of Assistant Commandant (Veterinary) by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a period of 02 years. Provided that the Controlling Authority may extend the period of probation in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government from time to time.

8 **Liability of service.** Any person appointed to any category of posts under these rules shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad.

9. **Private practice.** No person appointed to any post under these rules shall be permitted private practice including consultancy and laboratory practice.

10. **Superannuation**

Every person appointed under these rules shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he or she attains the age of sixty years or as prescribed by the Central Government from time to time.

Provided that a person whose date of birth is on the first of a month shall retire from service in the afternoon of the last day of the proceeding month or attaining the age of sixty years.

No person shall be granted extension in service beyond the prescribed age of retirement on superannuation.

11. **Seniority** The Inter-se-seniority of officers appointed to posts shall be determined in accordance with the general orders issued on the subject by the Central Government from time to time.

12. **Disqualification** – No person

- (i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the post;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

13. **Other conditions of service** - The persons appointed to the cadre shall be subject to the Central Reserve Police Force, Act, 1949 and Central Reserve Police Force Rules, 1955 as amended from time to time in respect of other conditions of service not specifically provided for in these rules.

The persons appointed on deputation from other departments shall have to wear the uniform prescribed for the combatised post against which they are appointed and have to undergo basic training as may be prescribed immediately on appointment on deputation.

14. **Power to relax:-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

15 **Saving:-** Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Class, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

16. **Interpretation :**

If any question relating to the interpretation of these rules arises, it shall be decided by the Central Government who shall decide the same.

17. **Medical fitness**

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, those persons who are medical category SHAPE-1, as specified in the MHA's Guidelines for recruitment medical examinations in CAPFs & AR OM dated 20.05.2015 and 31.05.2021 as amended from time to time and further subject to any instructions issued by the government from time to time shall be eligible for appointment under the provisions of these rules.

18. **Ineligibility of non-citizens of India:-**

No person who is not citizen of India shall, except with the prior permission of Central government in writing, be appointed under these rules.

Provided that nothing contained in this rule shall debar the appointment or employment of a subject of Nepal or Bhutan in the Force.

 - (i) Bachelor's Degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from a recognized University, and
 - (ii) Registration with Veterinary Council of India or any State Veterinary Council.

Note 1 : The departmental officers in the feeder categories who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on promotion.

Note 1 : The departmental officers in the feeder categories who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on promotion.

Note 2 : The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years.

Note 3 : The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty- six years as on the closing date of receipt of application.

For Ex-Servicemen :

Deputation/Re-Employment: The Armed Forces personnel due to retire or who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year and having qualifications and experience prescribed above for deputationists, shall also be considered. Such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces and thereafter they may be continued on re-employment basis.

Also Relexable upto five years in the case of Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe candidates and three years for Other Backward Classes and other special categories of personnel in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time).

Crucial date for calculation of the age limit

In the case of recruitment through the UPSC, the crucial date for determining the age limit shall be as advertised by the UPSC. In the case of other recruitments, the following note may be inserted according to the recruitment:-

Note:- The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Union Territories of Ladkha and Kashmir, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub Division of Chama District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands or the Union territory of Lakshadweep).

(i) Educational and Other qualifications:

- (a) Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from a recognized university.
- (b) Resignation with the Veterinary Council of India or any State Veterinary Council.

(ii) Physical Standard:

- (i) Height 157.5 cm for Male and 142 cms for Female (relexable by 2 cms for candidates falling in the categories of Gorkhas, Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Dogras, Maratha and candidates belonging to the State of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir region of IT Jammu

& Kashmir and UT of Ladakh and by 3 cms for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes)

(ii) Chest- 77 cms unexpanded and 82 cms expanded for Male only.

(iii) **Weight**-Proportionate to height and age as per the standard height weight chart prescribed by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt of India for direct recruitment in CAPFs
