

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE ASSAM ROYAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY

AND

THE CENTRAL RESERVE POLICE FORCE (CRPF)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is executed on this \_\_\_ day of 16/06, 2025, by and between:

Parties to the MoU

The Assam Royal Global University, a Private University established under The Assam Royal Global University Act, 2013, having its registered address at Betkuchi, NH-37, Opposite Tirupati Balaji Temple, Guwahati - 781035, Assam, India (hereinafter referred to as the "University"), which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns.

AND

The Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), a paramilitary force under the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, having its North East Zone registered address at 9<sup>th</sup> Mile, Amerigog, Guwahati-781023, Assam, India (hereinafter referred to as the "CRPF"), which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a formal collaboration between the University and CRPF for the provision of two distinct categories of academic scholarships for the benefit of eligible dependents and wards of CRPF personnel, thereby promoting access to quality higher education and honouring the service and sacrifices of personnel of the force.

### 3. Scholarship Categories

#### a) Royal Suraksha – 50% Scholarship

- i. Applicable to wards of **serving or retired personnel** of CRPF.
- ii. Covers **50% of the annual tuition fee** for approved undergraduate and postgraduate programmes offered by the University.
- iii. Students shall be responsible for the payment of all other applicable charges, including but not limited to registration fee, admission fee, caution deposit, hostel fee and transportation charges.

#### b) Royal Shaurya – Full Free ship (100% Scholarship)

- i. Applicable to wards of CRPF who have:
  - a) Laid down their lives in the line of duty.
  - b) Received recognized Gallantry Awards.
  - c) Died while performing bonafide government service.
- ii. Covers **100% of tuition fee, admission fee and registration fee** for eligible undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.
- iii. All other applicable charges, including hostel and transportation, are to be borne by the student.
- iv. A refundable caution money deposit of ₹10,000/- is applicable.

The above mentioned scholarships may be allowed on admissions to programmes regulated by statutory bodies such as AICTE, COA, PCI, INC, ANMHVC, BCI, or similar councils will be considered subject to seat availability and compliance with the respective council guidelines. These shall also align with the University's admission policy, and the final decision will rest with the University based on prevailing norms.

### 4. Eligibility and Selection Process

- a. Final approval and award of scholarship shall rest with the University's Scholarship Committee or such Competent Authority as designated by the University.
- b. Admission shall be granted subject to fulfilment of the minimum academic and program-specific eligibility criteria of the University.

**5. Continuation and Renewal of Scholarships**

The continuation of scholarships in subsequent academic years shall be subject to the following conditions:

- Maintenance of a minimum of **75% attendance** in all subjects in each semester.
- Successful clearance of all papers in each semester without any backlog.
- Adherence to the University's code of conduct and maintenance of satisfactory academic performance.

**6. Roles and Responsibilities**

**The University shall:**

- Allocate a maximum of five (05) scholarships for each academic year, regardless of the scholarship category applied for.
- Facilitate admission and scholarship processing for recommended candidates.
- Periodically inform CRPF regarding the academic performance of enrolled beneficiaries, if requested.

**The CRPF shall:**

1. Disseminate information regarding the scholarship schemes among its personnel.
2. Provide documentation support for verification of eligibility and service credentials.

**7. Validity and Termination**

- a) This MoU shall be valid for a period of **five (05) years** from the date of execution and may be extended upon mutual written agreement of the Parties.
- b) Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **six (06) months' prior written notice** to the other Party.
- c) Termination of the MoU shall not affect the continuation of scholarships already awarded, which shall remain valid for the full tenure of the respective academic programmes.

**8. Amendment**

This MoU may be amended or modified only by way of a written instrument duly executed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

**9. Dispute Resolution**

Any disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation. In the event such resolution is not possible, the matter shall be referred to the respective Competent Authorities of the University and the CRPF, whose decision shall be final and binding.

**10. MISCELLANEOUS**

(a) This MoU is not intended to provided any basis for investment or partnership decision at the present or in the future by and between the Parties, outside the scope of this MoU.

(b) Neither party may, nor cause any other party to, engage in any form of corruption or illegal or unethical act to obtain and maintain a business; including but not limited to; offering or paying a bribe or giving a gift or anything else of value to any official to improperly influence anyone in connection with their obligations hereunder. Neither party shall engage in or tolerate any kind of bribery and shall not promise, offer, provide, or authorize anything of value; including without limitations; payments, gifts, travel, meals, entertainment, political contributions, and contributions of any kind of nature, such as donations and sponsorships or favours, to any Government official to improperly influence any act or decision-making in violation of applicable law. Neither Party shall request, authorize, or tolerate any kind of bribery or any other kind of illegal or unethical actions from others on behalf of the other party, in the other party's name, or in any other way related to services.

(c) This MoU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous understandings and agreements whether written or oral between the Parties wrt the subject matter thereof.

11. This MoU is signed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity.

The Parties, hereby agree to the foregoing MoU, which shall be effective immediately upon full execution by the signatories listed below.

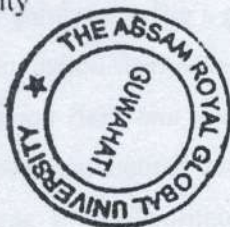
