1. Applications are invited from native tribal (Male/Female) youth from all districts of Nagaland State for filling up of 300 posts of constable/GD (Male/Female) through OPEN RALLY in Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF).

- (i) PST/PET of all eligible candidates will commence at respective rally centres as mentioned above in column No. 03 at 0500 Hrs for districts as mentioned above in column No. 02, from 21.10.2025 to 06.11.2025 (Except GH and Sundays).
- (ii) Written examination of all PST/PET successful candidates will be held on 22/11/2025 (Saturday). Centre for written examination along with time schedule will be displayed at respective recruitment centres.

Note:-

- Vacancies are exclusively meant for ST candidates only.**
- The posts are temporary but likely to become permanent.
- Above vacancies are calculated as per the guidelines issued vide MHA UO No. I.45023/04/2019/Pers.II (Pt. File)/800 dated 02/08/2022 i.e 50% vacancies distributed among whole State, 25% vacancies distributed among militancy areas and 25% vacancies distributed among border districts.

- In case the reserved 15% Quota of female ST candidates not filled due to non-availability of female ST candidates, their vacancy will be filled by male candidates.

4. DISTRICT OF DOMICILE:-

- Domicile /Permanent Residential Certificate (PRC):-
Candidates must belong to any districts of Nagaland State and should belong to ST category only.

- (ii) The candidates belong to any districts of Nagaland will only be considered for recruitment on production of valid “Domicile Certificate” issued by competent authorities so authorized by the concerned State/District to prove their domiciliary status. If Domicile certificate is not available, PRC (Permanent Residential Certificate) will also be accepted.

5. PAY & ALLOWANCES AND OTHER FACILITIES:-

- (i) The Pay level for the post will be Pay Level-3 (Rs.21,700-69,100). In addition, the post will also carry dearness allowances/Ration money as admissible from time to time, free accommodation, free medical facilities, free leave pass once in a year during leave as admissible under the rules of the Force.
- (ii) On appointment, candidate shall be governed under New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme effective from 01/01/2004.

6. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :-

(A) NATIONALITY/CITIZENSHIP

The candidate must be a citizen of India.

(B) EDUCATION QUALIFICATION

- (i) Minimum criteria for the candidate should be **10th class Pass**.
- (ii) Candidates must have writing/speaking knowledge of local language.

(C) AGE LIMIT:-

Age of the candidates must be between 18 to 28 years as on 01/08/2025 (including 05 years relaxation as applicable to ST candidates).

(D) PHYSICAL STANDARD TEST (PST)

(E) **PHYSICAL EFFIEIENCY TEST (PET)**

- (i) The candidates who meet the requirement of physical standard and qualified in PET (Race) will be allowed to appear in the written test. Candidates who do not fulfil the laid down physical standards will be eliminated for participation in the further process of recruitment.
- (ii) After qualifying in PST/PET, intimation for appearing in written test will be given to the candidates on the spot by the board.

(G) **GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT MEDICAL PARAMETERS:-**

Detailed medical examination will be conducted as per guidelines issued by the MHA. Some of the important parameters are as below:-

- (a) The minimum distant vision without correction and without wearing of glasses should be 6/6 of the better eye & up to 6/9 of the worse eye.
- (b) Further, **colour blindness will be a disqualification for the post** and if at any stage of their service career, if they are found to be colour blind, they will be boarded out as per SHAPE Policy in vogue.
- (c) The **candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint eyes**. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties. They should confirm to the medical standards prescribed by the Force and should be declared fit by the Medical Officers of CAPFs. The Medical certificate obtained from elsewhere will not be entertained.
- (d) Medical tests (X-Ray) chest PA view, Hemoglobin, Urine routine microscopic examination is must for all candidates under medical examination shall be conducted by Medical Officer of CRPF as prescribed in eligibility criteria as per new guidelines.
- (e) Testimonials of the candidates will be checked at the medical examination stage by the Recruitment Board.
- (f) **Relaxation of Tattoo:-**
As per MHA UO No. R.II-15/2013-Rectt(Tattoo) dated 02/03/2015 and letter/endorsement No. 1-45020/7/2012-Pers-II dated 19/07/2016, candidates having permanent tattoo on any part of the body will be debarred for recruitment in CAPFs and Assam Rifles. Candidates appearing in medical examination with tattoos removed surgically leaving a scar mark on the skin of candidates is accepted on the line of post injury or post burn scars in case there is no hindrance to the movement and physical performance.

7. APPLICATION:-

Application in prescribed format will be collected by the Board from the willing candidates at respective rally centers. Printed/ type written/ neatly handwritten in BLOCK LETTERS application in prescribed proforma (Appendix-A) on A-4 Size plain paper will have to be filled-up in blue/black ball pen and has to be submitted at the respective rally centers as mentioned in para-02. Blank application forms will be provided by CRPF at rally centers, if required.

8. APPLICATION FEE:-

No application fee from any candidate will be charged.

9. Appeal:-

- (i) The decision of the Recruitment Board in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), and selection will be final and binding on the candidates.
- (ii) Appeal from candidates who are not satisfied with their physical measurement will be accepted on the spot by the Appellate authority detailed for each centers. If candidate is found to be within the prescribed PST standard they will be allowed to appear in next process.

10. HOW TO APPLY:-

Candidates will have to report at specified location on the given date and time along with application form, original and photocopies of all testimonials as mentioned below:-

- a) Photocopies of 10th class pass certificate as proof of educational qualification and date of birth.
- b) ST Certificate in prescribed proforma.
- c) "Domicile Certificate/Permanent Residential Certificate" issued by the competent authority so authorized by the concerned State.
- d) Proof of identification in the form of Aadhar Card/Pan Card/Voter ID Card and Ration Card etc.
- e) Two recent passport size photographs (One should be pasted on the application form. The other photographs will bear name and signature of the candidate on the reverse side).
- f) Any other certificate in support of additional qualification.

11. WRITTEN EXAMINATION:-

Those who are declared fit in PST/PET will be called for written examination on a scheduled date & place.

The written Examination will consist of two papers.

Paper-I

- (i) 1st Paper will comprise non-OMR based objective type multiple choice questions.
- (ii) The 1st question paper will be of 100 marks comprising of 100 questions.
- (iii) The duration of question paper will be 02 hours.
- (iv) The question paper-1 of written examination will be set in Hindi (Devnagari script) & English language.
- (v) The question paper will comprise of General awareness, General Knowledge, General History and Culture of the region, knowledge of elementary mathematics, analytical aptitude and ability to observe.

(Note:- Minimum passing marks for qualifying the written examination for the post of CT/GD will be 20%.

Paper-II

- (i) 2nd paper will comprise descriptive/subjective type question (Both written and spoken) of local language.
- (ii) The 2nd question paper will comprise of two parts of 25 marks each.
- (iii) Part-I will comprise of 05 descriptive/subjective type questions in local language (05 marks for each question).
- (iv) The duration of question paper will be 1:30 hrs.
- (v) Part-II will consist of speaking test of local language.
- (vi) The question paper-II of written examination will consist of question related to local culture, traditions and topography etc. of the region/district concerned.

(Note:-Minimum passing marks for qualifying the written examination for the post of CT/GD will be 40%.

Result of the Written Examination will be displayed on the notice board of each recruitment rally centers as well as same will also be uploaded on CRPF website i.e. www.crpf.gov.in.

12. DRAWAL OF MERIT LIST

- i) After qualifying in Medical examination test, district-wise merit list will be drawn on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in written test.
- ii) In case of tie in marks, the merit list will be prepared in the following order:-
 - a) The candidate older in age gets preference.
 - b) If the tie still persists, it will be finally resolved by referring to the English alphabetical order of names i.e. a candidate whose first name begins with the letter which comes first in the alphabetical order, gets preference.

13. **FINAL SELECTION:**

- (i) The final selection of the candidates will be made in order of merit of each district as per allotment of vacancies.
- (ii) The list of finally selected candidates will be displayed on the notice board of recruitment centres and CRPF website (www.crpf.gov.in).
- (iii) Offer of appointment will be issued as per the availability of vacancies of each district in order of merit after verification of Character & Antecedents.
- (iv) An undertaking will be taken from all the selected candidates during the time of joining that, if at any stage of their service career, if they are found to be colour blind they will be boarded out as per the SHAPE Policy in vogue and same will also be enclosed in their Service Records.

14. **OTHER CONDITIONS**

- a) **Only ST candidates can apply and participate in the rally.**
- b) No Candidate shall be eligible: -
 - i) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or
 - ii) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contacted a marriage with any person.
- c) Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the detailed instructions contained in this notice of advertisement carefully.
- d) The candidate applying should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for the post. Their admission at all the stages of examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If upon verification, at any time before or after the written test and medical examination, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility condition, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the board.
- e) Candidates belonging to the physically handicapped category are not eligible to apply for this recruitment.
- f) Canvassing in any form or bringing outside influence will disqualify the candidate concerned.
- g) **Candidates will have to appear for the selection at their own expense and risk and no TA/DA will be admissible.** They should also make their own arrangements for stay during the process of recruitment.
- h) The department will not be responsible for any accident or injury or loss sustained during the course of test.
- i) Details of qualified candidates in PST/PET will be made available on the notice board of each rally centres on the same day.
- j) Date & venue of written examination will also be intimated on the notice board of respective centres.
- k) Candidates appointed will be liable to serve within or outside the Territory of India.

- l) In case of candidates appointed in CRPF and thereafter seeking resignation or discharge as per rule shall be required to remit to the Govt. a sum equal to three months pay and allowances or the cost of training imparted to him whichever is higher.
- m) **Mobile & accessories and other electronic gadgets are banned within the premises of the rally center/examination venue.** Candidature of candidates in possession of such gadgets in the recruitment Centre will be cancelled forthwith. The board considers such possession as adopting unfair means.
- n) The process of PST/PET shall be video graphed.
- o) Verification of character & antecedent of selected candidates will be verified from concerned Police authority prior to issue of offer of appointment.
