

MoU between CWA and RECT Education Trust, Bhilai

A MoU has been signed on 31/01/2024 between CWA and Rungta College of Engineering and Technology, Bhilai vide which RCET has offered 20 free seats in Engineering Curriculum wherein waiving all Tuition and Hostel Charges and 40% substantial discounted on the Total Fees to the wards/families subject to availability of seats in the College (.) **The** salient features of above MoU are as under (.)

A (.) Families of CRPF personnel through CWA will be offered admission in RCET based on the ages and eligibility of the wards of Engineering Curriculum.

B (.) It will be open to wards/families of serving, retired, and other CRPF personnel.

C (.) Wards/ Families of CRPF personnel enrolled in the 20 free seats shall not pay Tuition, Academic, Registration fees and Hostel Charges.

D (.) Wards enrolled other than above 20 free seats shall receive a substantial discount of 40% of overall fees.

(.) **SOP of admission and Timeline** (.) SOP of admission and Timeline of admission will be issued shortly and intimate to all formation accordingly (.)

(.) Besides this till date CRPF has Signed MoU with various reputed Institutions offering (229 Seats) as per list attached in appendix A (.)

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)
BETWEEN
Central Reserve Police Force (Represented by President
CWA)
AND
Rungta College of Engineering and Technology, Bhilai

1. Parties.

- a. The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) are the CRPF family Welfare Association (CWA) represented by its president (hereinafter called "CWA") having its address at Directorate General, CRPF BLOCK NO-1, CGO COMPLEX, LODHI ROAD, NEW DELHI-110003 and Rungta College of Engineering and Technology, Bhilai, having its campus in Rungta Educational Campus, Kohaka Road, kurud, Bhilai, Chhattisgarh represented by the Chairman (hereinafter called "RCET"). These entities are collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party" as the case may be.

2. Objectives.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is aimed to:-

- a. Provide a formal basis for initiating interaction between CWA/ its regional branches called RCWA and RCET.

- b. Welfare of wards of personnel through CWA by offering Technical Education to their wards. CWA is a non-profit organization run for the serving and retired CRPF families including that of the Martyrs and deceased Central Reserve Police Force personnel.

3. Plan

It is envisaged that CWA and RCET shall collaborate through the following:-

- a. Visits by faculty, students and other staff of RCET to establishments/Units of CRPF for the purpose of creating awareness and understanding of the CRPF among the youth of the country.
- b. Any other mode of interaction or communication related to spreading awareness of both institutions in areas and communities of mutual interest.
- c. Conduct of Technical education, including boarding where required and offered, as well as other educational services for wards/families of CRPF personnel.

4. Agreements for Collaboration

This MoU shall serve as an aegis for carrying out interaction in the areas of mutual interest with CWA and offer Technical education for wards/families of CRPF personnel (through CWA). The signing of this document does not entail any financial or legal obligation on either party. Essentially, this MoU is a framework within which activities shall be planned with the mutual consent of both parties, and through which wards of CRPF families shall be nominated and admitted to RCET. This MoU also provides the framework within which any subsequent agreements, replete with financial implications and relevant details can be signed if deemed necessary by the parties.

5. Administration

Each party will be represented by one person to act as the Joint Manager of this MoU. Secretary CWA will act as Joint Manager for CWA while Dr. Sanjeev Shukla will act as the Joint Manager for RCET.

Conduct of Technical Education Programme

6. Salient Features :

The Educational Programmes have the following salient features:-



- a. Families of CRPF Personnel through CWA will be offered admission in RCET based on the ages and eligibility of the wards for Engineering Curriculum.
- b. It will be open to wards/families of serving, retired, and other CRPF personnel.

c. Admission to the College

(i) Wards/Families of CRPF personnel (represented by CWA) will be offered **20 Free Seats in Engineering Curriculum** wherein we will be **waiving all Tuition and Hostel Charges. Also as well for the other students RCET is offering a concession of 40% on the Total Fees of the Engineering Curriculum for the CRPF wards/Families** subject to availability of seats in the College. The admission of any wards to the College shall always be subject to an interview with the academic staff, fulfilling the eligibility criteria and all other regulations of RCET.

(ii) Each candidate should have qualified XIIth Standard in Science stream with Mathematics and 45% from a recognized Education Board.



7. Financial Implications on Wards Enrolled in the College

a. Financial Provisions

The wards enrolled in the 20 free seats shall not pay any Admission, Tuition, Academic, Registration fees. The accommodation in the hostel is provided free of charge. However, there are expenses associated with food and other variable costs, such as electricity and maintenance, which need to be paid separately. Wards enrolled in the college outside of these 20 free seats shall receive a substantial discount (approximately 40% of overall fees).

b. Transport, Cafeteria, Boarding

Wards opting to avail the following facilities shall do so on a payment basis, subject to availability:

- (i) Transport to and from the Campus on the College Busses
- (ii) Food provided in the cafeterias
- (iii) Other auxiliary services offered by the College.

8. Sharing of Facilities :

Both CRPF and RCET shall allow the sharing of facilities as per the following arrangements:-



- a. Visits by faculty, students and staff of RCET to CRPF through CWA for spreading awareness and understanding of the CRPF and its role in the history and importance to the future of the nation by mutually agreed terms, if feasible.
- b. CRPF through CWA and RCET shall make provisions to share their respective facilities on case to case basis and mutually agreeable terms in order to promote academic interaction in the areas of cooperation.

9. Confidentiality

- a. Classified/Confidential information means information of material, regardless of its form, that in accordance with the laws, regulations or policies of a Party requires protection in the interests of national security or the wellbeing of the organization and its staff/students, and has so been designated with a security classification.
- b. If any personnel come in possession or knowledge of information which is confidential in nature, the same shall not be disclosed. In case of termination of



completion of tenure of MoU, all the relevant/sensitive information exchanged between the parties will be returned to the respective party or the parties in writing to ensure the security of such information.

- c. During the tenure of this MoU, both parties agree to maintain strict confidentiality of any information that the other Party has identified as confidential and will not disclose the same to any third party till such information falls into the public domain without negligence on the part of the recipient Party.
- d. In case of termination or completion of tenure of MoU, all the relevant/sensitive information exchanged between the parties will be returned to the respective party or the parties in writing to ensure the security of such information.

10. Validity :

This MoU will be effective from the date is signed by both the parties and shall be valid for a period of **five (5) years** thereafter. The requirement for and duration of the renewal shall be reviewed on completion of the first tenure. The Joint Managers may by mutual agreement, at any time and subject to written ratification by the appropriate authorities of each party



modify the scope and the agreements under this MoU. Such modifications/amendments shall come into force from the day of signing of such modification.

11. Dispute Resolution :

In case any dispute/claim arises between the parties wrt the MoU, including academic cooperation, validity, interpretation, implementation or alleged breach of any of its provision or regarding a question, including the questions as to whether the termination of this MoU by one party hereto has been legitimate, the parties here to shall endeavor to settle such dispute amicably through mutual discussions between the higher officer of the organizations. The amicable settlement shall be undertaken by the higher offices of the parties in order to undertake "genuine and good faith settlement" to resolve the dispute.

12. Termination :

Either party may, on giving "Current Academic Session or Six Months period which ever is later" notice in writing, propose to foreclose this MoU or renegotiate its conditions.



13. **Miscellaneous.**

a. Notices

All Notices given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing and shall be delivered to the Parties at respective addresses as stated herein above in the MoU or to the respective email IDs as provided herein below:-

b. This MoU is not intended to provide any basis for investment or partnership decision at the present or in the future by and between the Parties, outside the scope of this MoU.

c. Neither party may, nor cause any other party to, engage in any form of corruption or illegal or unethical act to obtain and maintain a business; including but not limited to; offering or paying a bribe or giving a gift or anything else of value to any official to improperly influence anyone in connection with their obligations hereunder.



14. This MoU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous understandings and agreements whether written oral between the Parties with respect to the subject matter thereof.
15. This MoU is signed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity.
16. The Parties, hereby agree to the foregoing MoU, which shall be effective immediately upon full execution by the signatories listed below:-
