

Financial Assistance from CWA

Guidelines for providing financial Assistance out of CWA to the Serving CRPF personnel and their family members including Martyred/ Deceased & Retired CRPF personnel

The guidelines for releasing funds out of the CRPF Family Welfare Association (CWA) are essential to ensure transparency, accountability and fairness in the distribution of financial support to deserving beneficiaries. These guidelines provide a clear framework for evaluating applications, verifying eligibility and disbursing funds, thereby preventing miss-utilization and misappropriation of funds. By establishing a standardized process, the guidelines also help to avoid discretionary decisions and ensure that financial support reaches those who need it the most, including Martyred/ Deceased/ Serving & Retired CRPF personnel and other eligible beneficiaries. Ultimately, the guidelines aim to promote a culture of integrity, efficiency and effectiveness in the management of CWA funds.

CRPF Family Welfare Association (CWA) provides financial assistance to personnel and NOKs in needs. Assistance is often targeted toward specific needs such as education, health, skill development, providing education aid like computers, laptops, tablets etc., providing aid to differently abled children or emergency relief.

Financial Assistance from CWA Fund

Who Can Apply

- i. Financial help can be given to the women/family members with no or low income to help them establish a source of earning and become financially independent (one time).
- ii. Financial help can be given to the Serving and retired CRPF personnel and their family members (**up to the rank of Inspector**).

Financial Assistance from CRPF Shaheed Fund CWA

Who Can Apply

- i) Financial help can be given to the **NOK of CRPF Martyrs/Deceased of all ranks**.
- ii) To the Veer Naari/family members with no or low income to help them establish a source of earning and become financially independent (one time).

1. Who Can Get Financial Help :-

- i) **Benefit will be extended to the serving CRPF personnel or family members as mentioned below:-**
 - a) Wife/Husband in case of married member of CRPF.
 - b) Children including step and adopted children.
 - c) Mother/Father of male/female member.
 - d) Unmarried dependant brother & Sister.
- ii) **The total yearly income of the family from all sources should be ₹3 lakh or less.**
- iii) **In special or exceptional cases, help may still be given after approval by the CEC Members of CWA.**

2. Purpose of Financial Assistance:-

Financial help may be provided for the following needs:-

- a) **Skill Development / Technical Courses** for vocational, short-term or job-oriented training courses.
- b) **Higher Education:-** Preferably for **meritorious students** and **students with disabilities**.
 - Assistance may be given as Scholarship (yearly)/Grant (one-time)/Financial help (one time)
- c) **Medical Assistance**
 - Financial help for medical treatment expenses that are **not covered** under CWF, SRF, CGHS and Ayushman Bharat or any other government medical schemes.

3. Documents Required:-

- Documents related to the educational institution.
- Income certificate showing income from all sources.
- Academic records.
- General documents such as: Dependent/NOK Card, Copy of PPO, Educational certificates.
- Patient's medical documents including copy of bills and receipts.
- Medical bills and expense records.

4. How to Apply:-

Application & Verification

- The application should be submitted through the nearest Regional CWA (RCWA) or HOO of GC/Unit or any institute of CRPF.
- Recommendation is required from concern **Sector HQ**.

Review & Approval

- The CEC Members of CWA will examine the application and documents.
- Final decision on providing financial help will be taken by the CEC.

5. Payment of Financial Assistance:-

- The amount will be paid through Regional CWA (RCWA)/Sector Headquarters/Head of Office (HOO) for further payment to the beneficiary.

Note:-

1. Beneficiaries must agree to follow all **terms and conditions** of the financial assistance.
2. **CRPF Family Welfare Association (CWA)** has the right to **change or stop** the financial assistance scheme at any time.
