PROCEDURE TO DEAL WITH FAILURES:

The failures in 1^{st} , 2^{ND} , 3^{RD} and 4^{th} Periodical tests will be given extra coaching in own time/spare time for a fortnight and will be retested in particular subject. However failure in Midterm and Final tests will result into relegation that will take place only at two stages i.e.

- i) The failure in Midterm test will be relegated to junor squads but ordinarily not more than twice during the entire period of the course. If recruit is to be relegated third time, Principal will himself examine him and assess as to whether the trainee is likely to become efficient member of the Force or otherwise.
