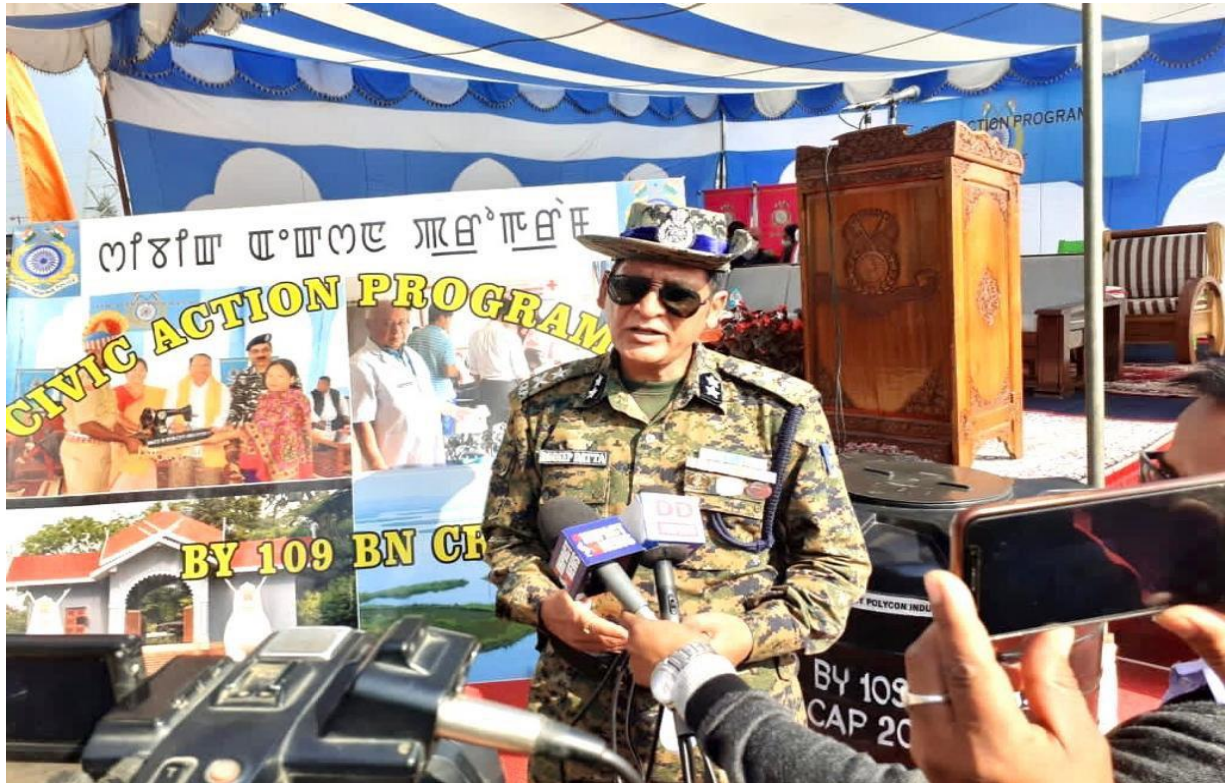
member, Micah Panmei, OC of Tamenglong police, Th Dominique also attended the programme and shared the dais.
