# Cops to be trained in crowd control by RAF

## Move Comes Amid Rising Challenges Faced By Police

- > Delhi Police has collaborated with Rapid Action Force's training academy in Meerut, UP, to train their personnel
- > Cops are being sent in batches of 75 since March 22 for a special two-week training

### WHY THIS TRAINING

- > Changing law and order scenarios after anti-CAA protests, Delhi riots and farmers' protest
- > Assembly of a much larger crowd than protests in the past
- > Multiple locations of protests being coordinated from a central point
- > Duration of protests increasing of late
- > Unpredictable and headless crowds becoming part of protests
- > Peaceful protests taking violent turn unexpectedly
