CRPF inks MOU with C-DAC to strengthen its tech capabilities

Thanking C-DAC for the collaboration, Sh. Kuldiep Singh, DG CRPF said that as the dependence on technology keeps increasing in the world, this association will benefit CRPF by making the experience, expertise, calibre and skill set of the C-DAC available to the Force. In his address, Dr. Hemant Darbari, DG, C-DAC said that the rapidly advancing technology entails the concept of learn, unlearn and relearn to keep up with the pace of advancements. He expressed his confidence that the MoU will go a long way in providing CRPF personnel with customised advanced courses aligned to the needs of the field and practical applications.

While several CRPF personnel have attended courses in CDAC earlier, the MoU will institutionalise the courses which will be attuned to the requirements of the force and emerging technology trends. On completion of the course, the participants will receive certificates or 'Post Graduation Diploma' based on the course duration.
