

Jorhat to Raj Ghat: CRPF's 2413 Km Cycle Rally flagged off

The Central Reserve Police Force has flagged off a Cycle Rally as a part of the the ongoing Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations which is an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of progressive India and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements from Rowrah, Jorhat, Assam in. This rally, which was flagged off from Jorhat By Shri Atul Bora, Agriculture Minister, Government of Assam, will culminate at Raj Ghat on 2nd October. Shri Topon Kumar Gogoi, Member of Parliament, Jorhat, Shri Hitendra Nath Goswami, MLA, and several senior officers of CRPF attended the flag-off ceremony. Olympic Champion and pride of the country, Lovlina Borgohain, motivated the Rally members by sharing the story of her remarkable journey to the coveted Olympics podium.

The minister lauded CRPF for its key role in upholding the unity and integrity of India and expressed his happiness that the Force was conducting a rally from Jorhat. He also felicitated families of Anjan Phukan, Manoranjan Bora and Najrul Hussain who made supreme sacrifice in the service of the nation.

The rally will culminate at Raj Ghat on 2nd October 2021, covering a total distance of 2413Km. It will traverse through Guwahati-Siliguri-Patna-Varanasi-Prayagraj-Kanpur to reach its destination at Raj Ghat while also visiting historically significant places related to freedom struggle enroute, cherishing the great sacrifices made by our freedom fighters and apprising people about historic celebrations of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

Of the four Cycle Rallies planned by CRPF, one from Kanyakumari to Raj Ghat has already been flagged off earlier this month. The two others from Ahmedabad and Jammu will be flagged off on suitable dates.
