Brief History of Rajasthan Sector

The Rajasthan Sector HQ came into existence at 83 Bn CRPF Campus, Lalwas, Jaipur on 07/04/2011. After commencing operations from Lalwas for about 3 months, in the month of June 2011, Sector HQ was shifted to the Kendriya Sadan located in Sector-10, Vidhyadhar Nagar, Jaipur, after being allotted office accommodation by CPWD.

Rajasthan Sector HQ was shifted from Vidhyadhar Nagar, Sector-10, Jaipur to new HQ campus village Nayala, District Jaipur in its

own land. The camp was beautifully developed to provide excellent infrastructure to SO's and Men. Consequent to shifting of Sector HQr to Nayala there was acute shortage of accommodation for SO's, ORs. Only 2 old pre fab huts were available for the use of sector personnel. They were very dilapidated condition were not at all fit for living of the force personnel in bad weather condition.

The Rajasthan Sector decided to make them habitable by getting them repaired and renovated with false ceiling plastering and floor tiles etc. on self-help basis through Pioneer Wing. It was decided to use old broken and damaged doors, windows, false ceilings, timber etc. removed during repair and renovation of barracks in GC-I Ajmer for the repair and renovation of these old structures.



With the help of Pioneer Wing the damaged and broken doors, windows, false ceilings and timbers were put to constructive use after separating obsolete and good useable parts after repairing and painting them.

Also several discarded tiles were purchased from local markets for flooring and walls of toilets and baths. Along with this, for the beautification of the campus, the rough land was levelled and filled with JCB. The campus was beautified by planting grass and different types of flowers, saplings. Twenty old toilets blocks were repaired and twenty new ones constructed. 2 Huge bathrooms for Jawans was constructed to facilitate comfortable bath for 20 personnel at a time. Old iron poles were fabricated by fitter staff to prepare platforms for over head water tanks to provide running water to all toilets kitchens and bathrooms. The high mast lights were fabricated

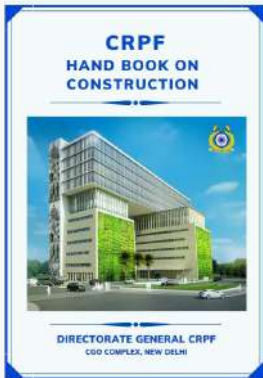


STADIUM IN THE GC - I AJMER

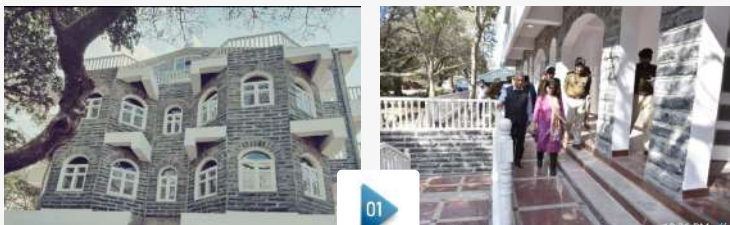

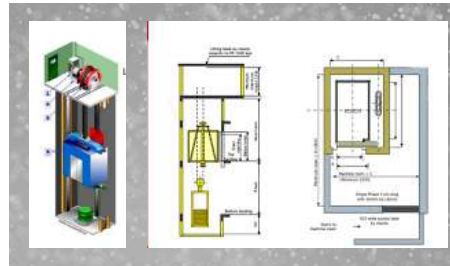


Building services Air conditioning /ventilation -duct laying -AHU (Air handling units), chillers
