Procedure to be followed for execution of works Departmentally by CRPF

Special Article

Rule-130 GFR 2017 specifies original works all as construction, site preparation, and alterations additions existing works, special repairs to newly purchased or previously abandoned buildings or structures, remodeling including or replacement.

Minor Works mean works which add capital value to existing assets but do not create new assets.

Repair Works means works undertaken to maintain building and fixtures. Works will also include services or goods incidental or consequential to the original or repair works.

AR &MO Works generally includes painting, white washing, distemper etc.

2. It must be clearly understood no new work irrespective of cost can be sanctioned and executed under Minor works/ AR&MO. Under minor works repair / renovation of existing assets can be executed. Addition of any infrastructure to the existing building / assets should be covered under Original Works. To quote an example construction of a new toilet or additional room to the existing building or construction of a small stretch of a road near the existing road comes under original works and cannot be executed under Minor Works /AR&MO. Minor Works AR&MO are primarily meant for

repair/renovation / maintenance of It is clarified that Officers of the existing assets.

Issue of Adm & Approval **Expenditure Sanction:**

- 3. Following Competent Financial Authorities (CFAs) have been given powers to accord adm. approval & issue expenditure sanction once the Preliminary Estimates have been vetted by the Competent Engineer Authority (CEA):-
- (A) Financial Power to accord adm approval & issue for job sanctions:

General duty Cadre, irrespective of their grade / rank/ academic qualification, cannot exercise power to Technical Works. As such Wing may execute Major works upto Rs. 15.00 Crore and Minor Works upto Rs. 1.00 Crore, the extant delegated per financial power to the DsG vide MHA's order No. II-27012/24/CF-274157/2014-PF.1 dated 05.09.2017, subject strict observance of CPWD Manual. Further power delegated to the Officers so appointed against the

4. Vetting of PEs:-

- 1. PEs prepared by SI(Civil) or any other authorized person of Battalions / GCs are to be countersigned by the Estate officer.
- 2. PEs should include calculation / measurement sheet.

- 3. Details of last repair and sanction in same building must be enclosed.
- 4. PEs prepared by CPWD do not require vetting and the Minor Work may be sanctioned by the Competent Financial Authority on whose Financial Power it falls (Refer to Table A).
- 5 Procedure to be followed once the adm approval & expenditure sanction has been issued by CFA::-
- 1. The tenders will be prepared as per GFR-2017 and CPWD norms by the concerned Estate Officer.
- 2. NITs are to be issued by CEA as per Table B.
- 3. Technical Sanctions will be issued by the CEA before uploading the Tender on the CPP Portal.
- 4. The Tenders should be uploaded

CPP (Central Public in Procurement) Portal. The Tenders will be forwarded the concerned CEA for approval of Technical Evaluation once they have been evaluated by the Tender Evaluation Committee at Estate Officer level. On approval of Tenders evaluation by the CEA the price bid will be opened to ascertain the lowest bidder amongst the technically evaluated tenderer. Estate Officer prepare the comparative statement and enclose the reason ability / justification of rates for the lowest Tenderer duly signed and forward to the CEA for acceptance. All the formalities related to checking documents, earnest money, security deposit performance guarantee etc. will be checked, ensured and

- completed by the respective Estate Officer where the works is to be executed.
- 5. In case the rates quoted by the lowest bidders are high/not iustified the same shall forwarded to this Directorate duly recommended by the Officer for re-tendering. On approval by this office, the process of re-tendering will commence.
- 6. Engineer In Charge will be appointed by the CEA who will be responsible to monitor and supervise the work. Engineer In Charge will be detailed by name by the CEA who will issue the operational work order to the Contractor. It is a formal order to Contractor to commence the work.
- 7. Payment to Contractor

Depending on the progress of work, payment will be made to the Contractor by the Engineer – In – Charge after carrying out the measurement of work in Measurement Book (MB) and preparation of Running Account (RA) Bill.

- 8. Completion of Work: On successful completion of work a Completion Certificate will be issued by the Engineer In Charge. It will be ensured that no over payment has been made to the Contractor and work is financially closed.
- 9. Handing/Taking over of Assets:
 A Board of Officers will be detailed to check the asset created and take over the same after preparation of the inventory.
