

**DETAILS OF MEDICAL CAMP ORGANIZED BY 65 BN, CRPF WITH AIIMS, RAIPUR  
UNDER CIVIC ACTION PLAN-2016 IN THE VILLAGE PIPERCHERI, DIST.  
GARIYABAND (CG)**

A Free Medical camp was organized during Civic Action Programme by 65 Bn and under the guidance of Director AIIMS Raipur Dr. Nitin Nagarkar in the village Pipercheri, District - Gariyaband, CG on 30/07/2016 by which villagers/patients of nearby area of Pipercheri got medical treatment by Orthopaedician, Cardiologist, ENT, Gynecologists & Pediatrics of AIIMS Raipur. During above medical camp more than 600 poor villagers were medically examined and free of cost medicines were distributed. An OPD card was issued to each patient by AIIMS Doctors and by which they can avail free medical facility at AIIMS Raipur for 01 year. Shri R.B. Singh, DIG Range Raipur, Shri A.K. Singh, Commandant 65 Bn, Smt. Shruti Singh, Collector, Dist. Gariyaband, Shri Amit Tukaram Kamble, SP Gariyaband and other administrative officers graced the occasion by their presence.

Before organizing the camp, Company commander C/65 Bn and Thana Incharge - Pipercheri met with Panch, Sarpanchs & Doctors of Primary Health centers of Pipercheri & nearby villages and informed them reg. organizing of Medical camp. Wide publicity of medical camp was done by poster, banner and pamphlets. Tent, Shamiyana, Fan, Chair, Table and PA equipment was provided by 65 Bn. To & fro transportation of Doctors of AIIMS from HQ/65 to C/65 Bn was provided by HQr/65. Separate seating arrangements were made for Sarpanch/ Panch and Journalists. Separate shamiyana counter for Doctors and separate OPD counter facility was also made available for female and male. Due to rainy season, temporary arrangement for medical camp was also made in under construction Police station building. Access control and area domination of camp was ensured. QAT team was also kept in ready position to avoid any untoward incident.

During medical camp, food was also provided to local villagers free of cost by 65 Bn. In addition to above, refreshment and lunch was also arranged for senior officers & AIIMS doctors, Journalists and print media persons.

Medicines were purchased by Unit Medical officer under the guidance and list provided by Director, AIIMS, Raipur. Medicines amounting Rs. 50,000/- were also distributed to approx 600 patients free of cost on advice slip of AIIMS doctors.

50 persons were found seriously ill by Doctors of AIIMS during above medical camp. Further they were assembled at C/65 location Pipercheri and were sent to AIIMS Raipur by Unit vehicle for further treatment. Their further treatment is also being taken care of by 65 Bn, CRPF.
