**Subject :- CRPF distributes Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Course Certificate to its 573 Tradesmen personnel**

CRPF organized a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Course Certificate distribution programme at SDG ground, Old JNU, Campus, New Delhi on 27/12/2016. 573 Course Certificates were distributed to trained tradesmen of CRPF personnel posted in Delhi & NCR by the Chief Guest Shri Rajeev Pratap Rudy, Hon'ble Minister for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in the presence of Special Guest Shri Kiren Rijiju, Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs and Shri K. Durga Prasad, DG, CRPF.

Addressing the gathering Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs, Shri Kiren Rijiju said that it was really an uphill task to train 573 personnel in such a short span of time.
