On 3rd May, 2017 representatives from Fire Safety Management visited CRPF Public School, Rohini. Students and teachers were told about litigation strategies in event of a fire. Principal, Mrs. Nidhi Chaudhary actively participated and encouraged all to learn the do's and don'ts in case of fire. Mr. Ajay Sharma of the Fire Safety Department first motivated children with inspirational words, where he spoke about will power and presence of mind. During the course of drill all were enlightened with intricate details such as Types of Fire, namely:

Class A	Combustible Materials (Eg. Paper, Plastic & Wood)
Class B	Flammable Liquids (Eg. Petrol, Oil & Paint)
Class C	Flammable Gases (Eg. Butane, Propone, Methane)
Class D	Flammable Metals (Eg Lithium, Magnesium)
Class E	Electrical Fires

Further, children were also acquainted with different types of Fire Extinguishers like:

- a. Dry Powder Type: Can be used on fires where one is not sure about the type of fire (Wood, Paper, Gaseous Fire, Flammable Liquids, Electrical Equipments)
- b. CO2 Based Type: Used for flammable liquids like Petrol, Oil & Electrical Equipment.
- c. Water Based Type: Most Commonly used on Wood, Petrol, Textiles etc.
- d. Wet Chemical Type: Cooking Oil Fires

Children were also taught the right technique of using a Fire extinguisher. Fire fighting department actually prepared one and all by generating awareness before any major catastrophe. It is noteworthy that CRPF Public School, Rohini was well equipped with different extinguishers well in advance, since every year an awareness campaign is conducted in this regard. This drill was indeed a great learning experience for all.
