Major Crackdown on Maoists in Jharkhand. Troops of CRPF alongwith State Police decimated 03 maoists dumps during week in the district of Gumla, Latehar and Palamu of Jharkhand state, during the operation troops recovered 09 weapons, live ammunitions, IEDs, Explosive items & accessories.

**Rebel ammo dump unearthed**  
Daltonganj: Cylinder and tiffin-box bombs, gunpowder, codex wires, detonators and acid bottles were unearthed by a joint team of 214 Battalion of the CRPF and the state police in Latehar district's Garu thana area on Wednesday.

On 24<sup>th</sup> March 2019, troops of 154 Bn CRPF alongwith State Police carried out search operation, in which troops recovered 06 weapons and explosive items etc. in the Chechariya forest of village Nimidaghat, under PS-Dumri, District Giridih, Jharkhand.

Sources said the recoveries had come as a shot in the arm for the security forces weeks before the district goes to polls on April 09.

"The dump where the explosives were found was an old one. The Maoists buried them as they found it to be a big burden for them," Bharti added.

Singh said the security forces, which found two bottles of acids and four bottles of chemicals, were yet to ascertain their composition.

Bharti said the Maoists were known to carry ammonium nitrate and sulphuric acid to make explosives.

Sources said the battalion had won the confidence of local people in Garu in Latehar district where it often leads a hand to help youths for online job applications and other official work.

The recoveries come exactly a month after a team of CRPF (134 battalion) and police busted a Maoist dump at Majuraha Pahar near village Bageera under Pipra thana area in the district.

The team recovered four IEDs, three guns, one radio set, 32 relatin sticks and 2 bags.

Two days ahead of PM Narendra Modi's visit to the district in January, a joint team of CRPF and district armed police personnel unearthed five improvised explosive devices (IEDs), along with grenades, wires and explosives from a Maoists' dump deep inside the jungles in Latehar district.

The recovered items included three tiffin bombs, two cooker bombs, three country-made grenades, six bundles of codex wire, two bundles of electric wire, a roll of black uniform fabric among other items.
