FAQs for Adoption of CRPF Retired K9s

- **1. Who is eligible to adopt a retired Police K9?**

Anyone who can provide a safe and loving home for the dog and meets the requirements outlined in the application process.

- **2. How can I apply to adopt a Police K9?**

You can browse available dogs on the adoption portal and then submit the K9 Adoption Application Form.

- **3. Is there an adoption fee?**

No, there is no adoption fee. However, adopters are responsible for traveling to the dog's location to collect the K9.

- **4. What happens after I submit my application?**

The responsible authorities will review your application, and if approved, you will be invited to meet the K9 to ensure compatibility before finalizing the adoption.

- **5. Do I need to sign an agreement?**

Yes, the adoption agreement will be signed in person when you collect the K9. The agreement shall be legally binding on the person/entity adopting.

- **6. Where do I collect the dog from?**

The adopter is responsible for traveling to the dog's current location to collect it. The location details will be provided once your application is approved.

- **7. What documents will I receive during the dog handover?**

You will receive the dog's KCI Registration certificate, medical records, vaccination details, and other relevant documents during the handover.

- **8. Will there be any follow-up after the adoption?**

Yes, periodical follow-up visits shall be conducted to ensure the dog is adjusting well to its new home.

- **9. What if I need help after adoption?**

We are committed to ensuring both you and the K9 have a successful transition. If you encounter any challenges, you can reach out to the nearest CRPF authorities for guidance and support.
