Central Reserve Police Force CRPF Organises Bharat Darshan Tour for Kashmiri Students

All the students thanked CRPF for this sort of kind gesture and promised to excel in their study and promote love for the country.

This batch of 22 students was the 18th and last group which was taken out on Bharat Darshan exposure tour to Chennai and Delhi. The earlier batches of students in the age group of 14-18 years have already visited places like Mumbai, Chennai, Hyderabad, Bangaluru and New Delhi.

More than 800 students, many of them belonging to BPL families of rural hinterland of Jammu and Kashmir, have been exposed to the rich socio-cultural diversity and historical legacy of the country through a series of Bharat Darshan Tour which began last December 2019.
