

50 CRPF Bravehearts donate blood in Kashmir

At least 50 Bravehearts of the 45 Battalion of CRPF deployed in Sumbal, Bandipora, J&K, voluntarily donated blood today. The blood donation camp was organised by the battalion in collaboration with the Indian Red Cross. Shri Iqbal Ahmad, Commandant 45 Bn inaugurated the camp, the collection from which has been donated to serve the needy in Govt Lal Ded Maternity Hospital. CRPF, having a strong social connect with the local population has been relentlessly working in the valley for social causes. While the force has a dedicated helpline 'Madadgaar' which the residents of J&K can contact for help, all the units are proactively reaching out to the society by different means. A few days earlier, more than 125 pints of blood was donated in Srinagar when 100 CRPF men volunteered in a camp organised by the Srinagar Sector.
