

Ration distribution drive by CRPF's Srinagar Sector culminates

The Srinagar Sector of CRPF has culminated its more than a week long ration distribution drive with the distribution camp at 117 Battalion CRPF Wazirbagh, Srinagar this Wednesday. Undertaken as a series of distribution camps spread across different battalions, the drive was conducted under the aegis of Srinagar sector CRPF with assistance from Sathya Sai Seva Organisation. The first camp was conducted by 115 Battalion on 22nd June at the Hydro Project, Ganderbal followed by camps by 43BN in Chadoora and 181Bn in Yousmarg on 23rd and by 118Bn in Baltal, Ganderbal on 25th June.

The Central Reserve Police Force strongly believes in reaching out to the countrymen in need. The ration distribution drive was aimed at helping those citizens in need whose life and livelihood have been affected by the pandemic. The beneficiaries were provided with 1 month ration and condiments. During the outbreak of the pandemic in 2020, the force had joined the nation in rendering aid to those in need. Ration and food distribution for migrant workers and the needy was done by the Force across its places of deployment which are spread throughout the country.
