2. Muskaan- The Smile Scheme:- Wheel chairs are being provided to the differently abled children through the interest generated

3. Sparsh- The mothers' Touch Scheme: Financial assistance @ Rs. 2000/- only to each new born girl child of CRPF personnel (Residing in CRPF Campus) & maximum up to 02 girl child per personnel is being provided.
4. CWA Sports Scholarship Scheme: Financial assistance of Rs. 25,000/- only is being provided to each achievers/participants at International level and Rs. 15,000/- to each achiever (Gold/Silver/Bronze medal winner) at national level to the wards of CRPF serving/retired/Martyr & deceased personnel and financial assistance is also being provided to the wards of CRPF serving/retired/Martyr & deceased personnel for the preparation to participate in International level sports events.
5. Wellness Education Eco – System: Financial Assistance to Group Centres/ Institutes for organising wellness education classes/ courses or training for wellbeing and eradicate stress /anxiety level of officers/Jawans and their family members through Ayush, Naturopathy, Art of living etc. Through the scheme financial assistance is also being provided for organising various Coaching, Career counselling, smart classes and courses for a group of students of CRPF serving/retired/Martyrs & deceased personnel.
6. Jindal Steel Works CSR Project (JSW): JSW company in collaboration with CRPF gives opportunity to NOKs and wards of martyrs/deceased/ serving personnel to undertake job oriented courses organised by USHA Company free of cost at various Regional CWA centres of country.
