3 Shaurya Chakras and 20 Gallantry Medals conferred on CRPF on 79th Independence Day

As the Nation celebrates the 79th Independence Day, the CRPF has been conferred with 23 Gallantry Medals, the highest among all the CAPFs. This prestigious recognition includes 3 Shaurya Chakras and 20 Gallantry Medals, elevating the CRPF's overall tally to 2731.

Besides, the name of Constable Saddam Hussain of 3 Battalion, CRPF has also been declared to receive Shaurya Chakra for his indomitable courage during a critical engagement with terrorists on November 5th, 2024 in Bandipora, Jammu and Kashmir. He fought gallantly, disregarding his own safety while charging the foreign terrorist with accurate firing of UBGL and was able to kill one Foreign Terrorist.
