CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME IN LAW SUBJECTS FOR DAGOS BY NLU DELHI

Directly appointed gazetted officers (DAGOs) of CRPF recruited through UPSC are getting their basic training in the CRPF Academy. This training is of 52 weeks that covers a variety of topics related to common soldierly skills and force specific and these topics are being covered in modular pattern through specialised faculty / institution. This enables systematic progression, harmonious development and continuity of instructions.

Major & Minor acts, CRPF act & rule, Enquiries and allied subjects are part of DAGOs training. National Law University was approached to design a law programme for CRPF officers that aim to deal with the legal aspects of challenging work environment and real world issues confronted by the company commanders of CRPF. The focus of the programme would be to enlighten the trainee officers on all legal aspects that are crucial for being a police officer who deals the internal security scenario of nation.

NLU New Delhi will conduct this programme in 72 class room lectures at their campus only and will cover the topics related to CrPC, IPC, IEA, Sensitization on protection of weaker sections, Minorities, Gender sensitivity etc. Classes for law module will start in mutual coordination as per basic training plan of DAGOs from 4th week onwards. The duration of this programme will be 36 days, 02 lectures of 01 hour each from Monday to Friday and will be organised in NLU campus. Trainees will be awarded a "Certificate programme in law subjects" after successful completion of this programme.

This MoU is second of its kind facilitated by CRPF Academy and the previous one being MoU with IIM Rohatak for a certificate programme in general management.
