JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

1 GENERAL

The Central Reserve Police Force has been entrusted the responsibility to conduct the 15th All India Police Rifle & Revolver/Pistol Shooting Championship, 2014 at GC, CRPF, Kadarpur, Gurgaon, (Haryana) from 10th to 14th November, 2014

The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the Rules & Regulations laid down by the All India Police Sports Control Board as amended from time to time and the conditions prescribed in the Geneal Rules of the All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi.

2. **VENUE**

The Group Centre, CRPF, Kadarpur, Gurgaon (Haryana) is a picturesque valley situated at the foothills of the Aravali range about 20 Kms from Gurgaon town on Gurgaon-Sohna Road. Its distance from New Delhi Railway Station is 50 Kms and from Indira Gandhi International Airport about 25 Kms.

3. **CLIMATE**

Weather during the month of November remains normal cold with temperature between 20° to 30° C. Therefore, the participants are advised to bring their light winter wears, adequate bedding and mosquito net etc.

4. **RECEPTION**

The receptions of the participating team will be arranged as per following schedule :-

- Officers arriving at Delhi by Air will be received at the Arrival Lounge of IGI Airport, Delhi.
- ii) The teams arriving by train will be received at the Delhi/New Delhi/Nizamuddin Railway Stations.
- iii) The teams travelling by road are requested to reach Group Centre, CRPF, Kadarpur, Gurgaon (**Route Chart enclosed**).

It is requested to intimate the date & mode of travel, well in advance for making proper arrangements in connection with reception, accommodation & conveyance. On arrival at Delhi, the participants are requested to contact our Reception Centres at the Airport/Railway Stations. The teams will be provided with a Liaison Officer (LO) for guiding them during the Championship. Participants are also requested to get their return journey reservations done in advance so as to avoid any inconvenience. All the teams are requested to report at the Venue at Full Bore Shooting Range, Group Centre, CRPF, Kadapur on 08/11/2014 positively.

5. **TRANSPORT**

Transportation from the place of arrival to the venue and daily conveyance to & fro from the place of stay to the venue of competition will be provided to the participants and officials which shall only be available from 8th November onwards. The Teams are requested to contact the Reception Centres/Organizing Secretary for the purpose.

Delhi Police, Haryana Police, Punjab Police, UP Police, Rajasthan Police, BSF, ITBP, CISF, RPF, SSB, NSG, NDRF are requested to make their own transport arrangements during the Championships.

6. **BOARDING & LODING**

Accommodation for the Teams shall be provided only w.e.f. 8th Nov,2014 onwards (Accommodation will be arranged at various places in Gurgaon). The details of participants should be sent to the Organizing Secretary by 30th September,2014 for making necessary arrangements. Delhi, Police, Haryana Police, BSF, ITBP, CISF, RPF, SSB, NSG, NDRF are requested to make their own arrangements of Boarding and lodging during the Championships.

The teams are advised to bring their own cooking utensils for preparing their own food. However, fresh ration & LPG gas will be provided from Co-operative Store, GC, CRPF, Gurgaon on cash payment.

7. MEDICAL FACILITIES

Medical facilities will be provided both at the place of accommodation and Games Venue.

8. ENTRIES

The participating teams are required to submit entry forms in prescribed format in triplicate with required entry fees duly signed by competent authority (Not below the rank of IGP as per AIPSCB Rules). A model entry form is enclosed herewith for information (Appendix-A). The completed entry forms alongwith the eligibility certificate & Entry fees @ Rs.50/- per participant including Team Manager, Reserve, Coaches, Doctors etc., in form of bank draft in favour of "The DIG(SPORTS) CRPF" payable at State Bank of India, Service Branch, New Delhi is required to be sent to the undersigned so as to reach here on or before the 10th Oct,2014.

9. MANAGERS' MEETING & CLINIC

A meeting of Team Managers/Coaches will be held on 9th Nov,2014(FN) at 1100 hrs. at GC, CRPF, Kadarpur, Gurgaon for briefing on the Championship. Copy of the programme of the competition will be provided to the Team Managers/Coaches during this meeting. The copy of the program will be handed over to the teams just after the draw is over.

10. REHEARSAL FOR OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

Rehearsal of march-past for opening and closing ceremony will be held at GC, CRPF, Kadarpur Campus. The date and time for rehearsal will be intimated to the teams on arrival.

11. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

Opening Ceremony will be held on 10th Nov, 2014 Forenoon and Closing ceremony will be held on 14th November, 2014 in Afternoon. The Dress code for both the ceremonies will be service uniforms.

All the participating teams should bring **two flags of size 4 feet x 6 feet x 2 feet** of their respective organization, which would be required for hoisting and March pasts/Line up respectively during the Game.

12. **PRACTICE**

The shooting range at GC, CRPF, Kadarpur, where the competition being held, will not be made available to the participants before the competition due to various Administrative reasons.

13. CONDUCT OF THE GAMES

The 15th AIPDM Shooting,2014 shall be conducted on the terms and conditions as laid down by the AIPSCB at GC, CRPF, Gurgaon (Haryana).

14. ARMS, AMMUNITION AND OTHER EQUIPMENTS

All teams will be responsible for keeping their Arms, Ammunition and other equipments related to Shooting Championship under their own custody.

15. RULES & REGULATIONS

The rule book provided by the Ail India Police Sports Control Board may please be referred. However, the amendments are attached with this circular.

16. **CONTROL ROOM**

A Central Control Room will function with effect from 01/11/2014 till completion of the competition. Arrival and departure of the teams will be registered in the control room. Other communication facility related to the competition will be made available.

17. CO-ORDINATION/CORRESPONDENCE

The Organizing Secretary is the Co-ordinating authority for the Games. 
