2. The tenderer who are dealing in drugs/Pharmaceutical items must hold valid drug license issued by the competent authority.

3. Tenderers are advised to go through the Earnest Money and Payment terms, condition for pre-qualification of tender submission and other clause of this Tender Enquiry carefully before filling the Tender.

4. All Tender documents attached with this Notice Invitation to tender including specifications are SACROSANCT for considering any offer as complete offer and will be treated as accepted for the same product i.e acceptance of all terms and conditions of this tender.

It is therefore important that each page of the tender document is duly completed and signed and returned with your offer.

5. All firms who are not specifically registered for required stores as per specification of Notice Inviting Tender either with DGS&D/CPMP or with NSIC, are required to submit Earnest Money as mentioned above along with their offer. Registration with any other organization will not exempt them from depositing Earnest Money. As per Government policy, PSUs are not exempted from depositing EMD.

6 Bidders should quote rates, taxes, duties as per Price Bid format provided.

7 Bidders are allowed to attend pre-bid meeting in case of any doubt regarding tender documents submission.

8 Purchaser reserves the right to change the consignee and change the quantity of stores allotted to them.

9 Purchaser reserves the right to get the manufacturing capacity of all firms re-verified irrespective of the registration status.

10 Purchaser reserves the right to cancel/reject or scrap the tender without assigning any reason at any stage. He can also reject any one or more of the bidders which are not fulfilling any one or more of the condition of tender notification.

11 Purchaser has the right to increase or decrease the quantity of any or more items or delete any item from the demanded list even after acceptance of the tender but before the supply order.

12 The price bid of eligible firms will be opened and order would be considered on the lowest bidders subject to their capacity and performance shown in previous years etc.

13. To qualify, as successful the bidders at least 80% of the demanded items be quoted, if they vouch for less than 80 % of the items, their tender will not be considered.

14 All documents enclosed with the tender should be legible and readable. Illegible, unclear, unreadable documents/copies of documents will be considered non-submitted and the purchaser will have right to reject such bid.

15 Bidders who have experience in bulk supply of similar items during last 3 year should only apply. Experience in retail supply/selling will not be considered.

16 Bidders whose behavior has been observed to be suspicious, obstructive in official work and threat to security will be summarily rejected and in this regard decision of purchaser will be final and binding.

17 Shelf life of pharmaceutical products should not be less than 1 year at the time of delivery.

18 Delivery period counting will count from the next day of issue of supply order and Intervening Sundays/holidays will not be exempted.

19 a)Tenderer are required to submit last 03 years performance statement separately for each year with reference to the type of supply .

b) The vendor may attach dealership certificates with respect to the items they wish to quote. Dealer ship certificate will not be binding on the purchaser to accept or reject the offer.

20. Rate quoted by the firms should be on firm price basis.

21. Bidders should quote rates, taxes, duties as per Price Bid format provided.

22. The firms should not be blacklisted / debarred / banned by any State Governments U.T. / Central Government/Corporations/Local Government Bodies in the preceding 3 years.

However bidders are required to submit Tender Fee /EMD as applicable / mentioned in the tender while submitting the bids. The Demand Draft for Tender Fee /EMD should be drawn in favour of IG(Medical)/MS, Composite Hospital, CRPF, Bantalab, Jammu payable at **SBI, Bantalab, BANK CODE NO.10347** and should be submitted along with other documents in the tender box kept at office of the

Composite Hospital, CRPF, Bantalab, Jammu before specified time and date mentioned in the Schedule to Tender.

25 **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** -

In case the firm does not complete the supply within delivery period, liquidated damages will be charged @ 2% of the value of the contract as per Para 15.7 of DGS&D Manual and 14.7(1) of DGS&D-68 Revised and if required, action will be taken against the firm to Blacklist/Debar it from further participation in the tenders and also forfeiture of its security deposit/earnest money.

26 **DEMONSTRATION TRIAL:** Not Required.

27 **WARRANTY CLAUSE:-** Not Required.

28 Tenderers are not permitted to alter or modify their tenders after expiry of the deadline for receipt of tender till the date of validity of tender and if they do so their earnest money will be forfeited.

29 a) Full name and status of the person signing the tender documents must be clearly mentioned.

b) The firms applying tenders against the subject Tender Enquiry are informed that all relevant details with reference to the Tender Enquiry stipulations are clearly responded to. In case any of the Tender Enquiry stipulations are not clearly stated to/replied to by any of the bidders, no repeat no clarifications will be sought from the concerned bidder and its offer will be rejected out rightly.

c) Before submission of tender, tenderer will check the Check List attached to these Tender Documents as enclosed Appendix-A for compliance on various stipulations of the tender.

30 **CONDITIONS REGARDING DEPOSIT OF EARNEST MONEY.**

a). All firms who are not specifically registered with DGS&D or NSIC for the stores for which the offers are invited, are required to deposit **EARNEST** money equivalent to the amount as mentioned in the Tender Schedule, failing which their offer will be summarily rejected.

b). For claiming exemption from depositing earnest money, the tender should be registered with DGS&D or NSIC specifically for the stores with specification as mentioned in Tender schedule. Firms which are not specifically registered for the stores with specification as mentioned in the Tender Schedule, either with DGS&D or with NSIC, shall be treated as unregistered and shall be required to deposit earnest money as above.

c). Similarly firms, who are specifically registered for the stores as per specified Specifications with DGS&D/ NSIC, but with a certain MONETARY LIMIT, will be treated as UNREGISTERED for their value exceeding their monetary limit of registration. Such firms shall be required to deposit proportionate earnest money over and above the monetary limit. In case such firms fail to deposit Earnest Money, their offer for the tender value exceeding their monetary limit is liable to be ignored.

- d). The Earnest Money can be deposited in any of the following alternative forms:
- i) An Account Payee **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of IG(Medical), Composite Hospital, CRPF, Bantalab, Jammu and payable at SBI Bantalab, Jammu (Code No. 10347)
 - ii) **Fixed Deposit Receipt.**
 - iii) **Banker's Cheque**
 - iv) **Bank Guarantee** from any of the commercial banks in an acceptable form (in the attached format)
- e). The earnest money shall be deposited with the purchaser for the period of 90 days from the date of opening of tender. If the validity of the tender is extended, the validity of the BG / or any other alternate document submitted in lieu of Earnest money will also be suitably extended by the tenderer, failing which their tender after the expiry of the aforesaid period shall not be considered by the purchaser.
- f). No interest shall be payable by the purchaser on the Earnest Money deposited by the tenderer.
- g) The Earnest Money deposited is liable to be forfeited if the tenderer withdraws or amends, impairs or derogate from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of his tender.
- h). The earnest money of the successful tenderer shall be returned after supply of Medicines.
- i). Earnest Money of all the unsuccessful tenderer shall be returned by the purchaser as soon as possible, not later than 30 days after Placement of contract. Tenderers are advised to send a **pre-receipt challan** along with their bids so that refund of Earnest Money can be made in time.
- j). Any tender, where the tenderer is required to deposit Earnest Money in terms of Conditions mentioned in preceding paras, not accompanied with Earnest Money in any one of the approved forms acceptable to the purchaser, shall be rejected.

31 **Performance Security Deposit**

The successful bidder will be required to deposit 5% of the contract value as Performance Security for the due performance of the contract in favour of The IG(Medical), Composite Hospital, CRPF, Bantalab, Jammu, payable at State Bank of India, Bantalab, Jammu-Code No.10347, by draft / Bankers cheque / FD till completion of supply of the contract items within seven days from the date of issue of Supply order.

32 **OPTION CLAUSE:**

- (a) The purchaser reserves the right to place order of the successful tenderer for additional quantity offered by them at the rates quoted at the time of placement of contract or during the currency of the contract as per clause 31 of form DGS&D.
- (b) The purchaser reserves the right to place order on the next higher successful firms if the firms quoting lower rates is not able to supply the demanded items.

- (a) **ADVANCE SAMPLE.** Not required
 - (b) **REFERENCE SAMPLE:** Not required

(c) **TENDER SAMPLE :** Not required

34 **GUARANTEE / WARRANTY:** Not Required.

35 In the event of contract being cancelled for any breach committed and the purchaser affecting re-purchase of the stores at the risk and the cost of the contractor, the purchaser is not bound to accept the lower offer of Benami or allied or sister concern of the contractor.

36 Purchaser will not pay separately for transit insurance and the supplier will be responsible till the entire stores contracted for, arrive in good condition at the destination. The consignee, as soon as possible but not later than 15 days of the date of arrival of the stores at destination, notify to the contractor any loss or damages to the stores that may have occurred during the transit.

37 **EXCISE DUTY:** Not Required.

38 **GOVT. POLICY**

The purchaser reserves the option to give a purchase/price preference to offers from the public sector units and / or from other firms in accordance with the policies of the Govt. from time to time.

39. **COUNTER OFFER:-**

If L-1 firm(s) is not able to meet/supply the full quantity, a counter offer for the remaining quantities will be given to the remaining eligible and technically qualified tenderers in the tender process, asking them to confirm acceptance of L-1 rates. The remaining eligible and technically qualified tenderers will be asked to give their acceptance or otherwise in writing,(in sealed envelopes) to the purchasing authority by a date and time(to be deposited either by hand or in the tender box). Depending upon the written confirmation / acceptance / denial of acceptance of L-1 rates, the competent authority will take a final decision for distribution of remaining quantities at L-1 rates to other eligible tenderers who have accepted the counter offer of L-1 rates based on their monetary capacity, production capacity etc but strictly with reference to the delivery period and schedule of delivery including inspection period already disclosed in the tender enquiry documents. It may also be ensured that during this stage none of the eligible tendering firm who have accepted the counter offer will be allowed to give a revised commercial offer.

40. **AMENDMENTS IN THE PAMPHLET ENTITLED CONDITION ON CONTRACT**

1. The following amendments may be carried out in the pamphlet entitled conditions on contract governing the contracts placed by Central Purchase Organization of Government of India 1991 edition bearing Symbol DGS&D-39 Form No. DGS&D Form No. DGS&D-68 (Revised).

1.1: The definition of "Government" provided in clause 1 (f) page 2 of DGS&D Conditions of Contract may be amended as under:-

"Government" means the Central Government".

1.2 : The definition of Secretary in clause I(k) page 3 of DGS&D Conditions of Contract may be modified as under:-

“Secretary” means Secretary of Min. of Home Affairs for the time being in administrative charge of the subject matter of contract and includes Additional Secretary, Special Secretary, Joint Secretary, or Director or Dy. Secy. In such Ministry, D.G., Addl. DG,IG(Medical), Composite Hospital, CRPF, Bantalab, Jammu and any other officer authorized for the time being to execute contracts relating to purchase and supply of stores on behalf of the President of India”.

1.3 : Under Clause 2© page 5 of DGS&D conditions of contract, the word “Director General of Supplies and Disposals or heads of his concerned regional offices” may be replaced by IG(Medical) / MS, Composite Hospital, CRPF, Bantalab, Jammu.

1.4 : Clause 24 i.e. Arbitration:-

For : The existing entries.

Read: Arbitration.

In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under these conditions or any special conditions of contract, or in connection with this contract (Except as to any matters, the decision of which is specifically provided for by these or the special conditions), the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of an officer in the Min. of law, appointed to be arbitrator by Director General, CRPF. It will be no objection that the arbitrator is a Government servant that he had to deal with the matters to which the contract relates or that in the course of his duties as a government servant he has expressed views on all or any of the matters in dispute or difference. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to this contract, it is term of this contract that:-

a) If the arbitrator be a person appointed by the DG CRPF:-

In the event of his dying, neglecting or refusing to act, or resigning or being unable to act, for any reason or his award being set aside by the court for any reason, it shall be lawful for Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs either to proceed with the reference himself or to appoint another person as Arbitrator in place of the outgoing Arbitrator in every such case, it shall be lawful for the DG CRPF in place of the outgoing Arbitrator, as the case may be to act on record of the proceeding as then taken in arbitration, or to commence the proceedings denovo as he may at his discretion decide.

b) It is further a term of this contract that no person other than the person appointed by him should act as Arbitrator and that if for any reason that is not possible, the matter is not to be referred to arbitration at all.

c) The arbitrator may with the consent of all the parties to the contract enlarge the time from time to time for making and publishing the award.

d) Upon every and any such reference, the assessment of the cost incidental to the reference and award respectively shall be in the discretion of the arbitrator.

e) Subject as aforesaid, the Arbitration Act, 1940 and the rules there under and any statutory modification thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply the arbitration proceedings under this clause.

f) The venue of arbitration shall be the place where the contract is concluded or such other place as the DG CRPF at his discretion may determine.

g) In this clause the expression the DG CRPF means the DG CRPF of the Ministry of Home Affairs for the time being and includes, if there be no DG ,the Officer who is for the time being the administrative head of the CRPF, whether in addition to other functions or otherwise.

1.5 : Similarly, the reference to DGS&D wherever appearing may be suitably modified.

Instructions for Online Bid Submission

Instructions to the Bidders to submit the bids online through' the Central Public Procurement Portal for eProcurement at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>

- 1) Bidder will submit the bids online through the Central Public Procurement Portal for e-Procurement at <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>
- 2) Possession of valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) and enrollment/registration of the contractors/bidders on the eProcurement / eTender portal is a prerequisite for e-tendering.
- 3) Bidder should do the enrollment in the e-Procurement site using the “Click here to Enroll” option available on the home page. Portal enrollment is generally free of charge. During enrollment/registration, the bidders should provide the correct/true information including valid email_id. All the correspondence shall be made directly with the contractors/bidders through email_id provided.
- 4) Bidder need to login to the site thro' their user ID/ password chosen during enrollment/registration.
- 5) Then the Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by SIFY/TCS/nCode/eMudra or any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India on e-Token/Smart Card, should be registered.
