**G.S.R.....-** In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 of Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (66 of 1949), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Inspector (Hindi Translator) and Sub Inspector (Hindi Translator), in the Central Reserve Police Force, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely :-

1. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the Central Reserve Police Force, Inspector (Hindi Translator) and Sub Inspector (Hindi Translator), Recruitment Rules, 2020.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in Official Gazette.
2. **Application.**- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column(1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix.** - The number of the posts, their classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
4. **Disqualification.** - No person, -
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Medical Fitness.** – Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, only those persons who are in medical category SHAPE-I, shall be eligible for appointment under the provisions of these rules.
6. **Power to relax.** – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving.** – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
