G.S.R.--- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 18 of the Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (66 of 1949), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment for the post of Assistant Sub Inspector (Pharmacist) of Med/Veterinary Component of Group- 'C' post in the Central Reserve Police Force, namely: -

Short title and commencement. -

(i) These rules may be called the Central Reserve Police Force, Group- 'C' (Combatised Para Medical posts) Recruitment Rules - 2021

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** - The number of posts, their classification, level in pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in column (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.**- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.** - No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Physical standard for direct recruitment.** - as per Part IV of the Central Reserve Police Force Recruitment Manual, 1975,

(a) Height : For Male - 170 cms.
For Female - 157cms.

(b) Chest : For Male: Unexpanded - 80 cms. and
Expanded - Minimum expansion 5 cms.
For Female - Not applicable.

(c) Weight : For Male and Female:
Proportionate to height and age as per medical standards.

(d) Eye Sight : The minimum distance vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses.

(e) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they shall possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect which likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

6. **Relaxation:** The Relaxation will be permissible in height and chest to the candidates as follows. -
- (i) **Height:** Minimum height of candidates falling the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, State of Jammu and Kashmir will be 165 cms. for male and 155 cms. for females. The minimum height for all candidates belongs to the Scheduled Tribes will be 162.5 cms. for males and 150 cms. for females.
- (ii) **Chest:** The minimum chest of male candidates falling in the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, State of Jammu and Kashmir will be 78 cms. with minimum 5 cms. expansion. The minimum chest for all male candidates belonging to the Schedule Tribes will be 76 cms. with minimum 5 cms. expansion.
7. **Physical Efficiency Test.-**
- (a) **Race**
- (i) For Male : 1 mile in 7.5 minutes.
(ii) For Female : 800 mtrs. in 6 minutes.
- (b) **Long Jump**
- (i) For Male : 10 feet (ii) For Female: 6 feet
- (c) **High Jump**
- (i) For Male : 3 feet (ii) For Female : 2.5 feet.
8. **Liability to serve** – Any person appointed to any post under rules shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or aboard.
9. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of person.
10. **Saving-** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
