G.S.R _____(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 18 of the Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (66 of 1949) and in partial supersession of the Central Reserve Police Force Group 'C' (General Duty/Tech/Tradesmen) Cadre Recruitment Rules, 2010 and Group 'C' (Combatised Para-Medical Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2011, in so far as they relate to the posts of Constable (Cook), Constable (Water Carrier), Constable (Masalchi), Constable (Kahar) and Constable (Table Boy), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such suppression, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Constable (Kitchen Services) Group 'C' post in the Central Reserve Police Force under the Ministry of Home Affairs,

- 1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Central Reserve Police Force, Constable (Kitchen Services) Kitchen Services Cadre Group 'C' post Recruitment Rules, 2021.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application. -**These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix. -** The number of said post, its classifications and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in column (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4(a) **Initial Constitution.-**

(1) Personnel holding the posts specified in the Column (1) of Schedule annexed herein, immediately before the commencement of these rules on the regular basis shall be deemed to have been appointed in accordance with the provisions of these rules.

(2) The regular continuous service of personnel referred in Sub-rule(1) in the respective grades immediately before the commencement of these rules shall count for the purpose of probation period, qualifying service for promotion, confirmation and pension in the service.

5. **Disqualification.-** No person,-

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Medical fitness.-** Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, those persons who are in medical category SHAPE-1, as specified in the MHA's Guidelines for recruitment medical examination in CAPFs & ARs dated 20/05/2015 and further instructions issued by MHA from time to time, shall be eligible for appointment under the provisions of these rules.

7. **Power to relax.**- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. **Ineligibility of Non-citizens of India.**-No person who is not a citizen of India shall, except with the prior permission of the Central Government in writing, be appointed under these rules:

Provided that nothing contained in this rule shall debar the appointment or employment of a subject of Nepal or Bhutan in the Force.

9. **Superannuation.**- Every person appointed under these rules shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he or she attains the age of sixty years or as prescribed by the Central Government from time to time.

Provided that a person whose date of birth is on the first of a month shall retire from service in the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of sixty years.

(2) No person shall be granted extension in service beyond the prescribed age of retirement on superannuation.

10. **Saving.**- Nothing in these rule shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and others special categories of persons, in accordance with orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

11. **Interpretation.**-If any question relating to the interpretation of these rules arises, it shall be referred to the Central Government who shall decide the same.
