**NOTIFICATION**

G.S.R \_\_\_\_\_(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 sub-section (1) of the Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (66 of 1949) and in supersession of the Central Reserve Police Force Pioneer Cadre (Group B and C Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2010 and Central Reserve Police Force Pioneer Cadre (Group B and C Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2016 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such suppression, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group B and C Posts in the Pioneer Cadre in the Central Reserve Police Force, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the Central Reserve Police Force, Pioneer Cadre (Group B and C Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2022.  
  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** - The number of the posts, its classifications and **the level in the pay matrix** attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications, etc.**- The method of recruitment to the said posts, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in **columns (5) to (13)** of the above said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.-** No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and others special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Age-limit for direct recruits.**

Between 21 to 30 years. (Relaxable for Government Servant up to 5 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time).

Note :- The crucial date for determining the age limit in each case shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for other than those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti district and Pangi Sub-division of Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands or Lakshadweep).

**Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits.**

Intermediate with three years diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized Board/Institution or University or equivalent.

(1) Must possess the following minimum physical and medical standard namely:-

(a) Height-170 Cm

(b) Chest-80 Cm (Un-expanded) and

85 Cm(Expanded)

Weight : Corresponding to height.

(2) Eye sight:

The minimum distance vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 both eyes without correction i.e. without wearing of glasses.

(3) Colour vision : The candidates must possess high colour vision.

(4) The candidates must not have knock-knee, varicose vein, flat foot or squint in eyes and they must be in good mental and bodily health and free from and physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

(5) Candidates will have to pass the **Written test, Physical Efficiency Test and Medical Examination.**

The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

The departmental officers in the feeder categories who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly the deputationist shall not be eligible for appointment on promotion.

**Note:-** Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such or qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade amongst their junior who have completed such qualifying or eligibility services.

(The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre

- (b) Preference will be given to those having certificate of trade from recognised Industrial Training Institute.

Weight-Proportionate to height and age as per medical standards.

- 4. **Colour Vision:** The candidates should possess high colour vision.
- 5. The candidates must not have knock-knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and must be in good mental and bodily health and free from and physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.
- 6. Candidates will have to pass the Physical Standard Test/Physical Efficiency Test, Written Test and Medical Examination.
