

CRPF establishes two new camps in Chhattisgarh

Committed to tackle the Maoist menace in the LWE affected regions of the country, the Central Reserve Police Force has established two new Forward Operating bases (FOBs) in Chhattisgarh.

2. These FOBs have been established in Dubbakonta (PS Chintagupha, Dist Sukma) and Nambi (PS Usoor, Dist Bijapur). Both the locations used to be strongholds of Maoists. With the establishments of these new camps, in the most interior areas, will give an edge to the Security Forces as these will serve as a launch pad for offensive operations against Maoists close to their hideouts.

3. The presence of security forces will not only weaken the supply lines of Maoist and flush them out from these areas but will provide much needed fillip to the developmental activities in the area.
