1. Item rate bids are invited on behalf of President of India from approved over all lowest rate and registered civil contractors and those on appropriate list of CPWD, PWD/BRO/Railway or Central Govt. and State Govt. etc. for **Re-carpeting of road of Parade Ground and from Gate No.1 to Roundabout Shaurya Sthal at Group Centre, CRPF, Kadarapur, Gurugram.** The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 93, 92,789/-** (including GST and all other applicable taxes) this estimate however, is given nearly as a rough guide.
2. Intending bidder is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of competent authority on the eligibility criteria. E-registration/enlistment in appropriate class, experience Certificate etc. However, if the intending tenderers want to see the tender document before giving application and Bid Declaration Certificate, same may be seen in the office of the DIGP, GC, CRPF, Gurugram (Haryana) -122101 on any working day.
3. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of this said form which will form part of the agreement.
4. The successful bidder will require depositing performance security (**i.e. 3% of @total contract value**) before issuing work order.
5. The time allowed for carrying out the **work will be 10 days** from the day after the date of written orders to commence the work or from the first date of handing over the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing if any, indicated in the tender documents.
 - a. The site for the work is available.
 - b. The bid documents consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various type of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be compiled with and other necessary documents except standard general conditions of contract form can be seen on web site www.eprocurement.com or www.crfp.nic.gov.in
 - c. The bidder will also produce scanned copy of PAN issued by concerned income Tax office. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
6. Only e-tenderers will be accepted.
7. The description of the work is as follows: -

Re-carpeting of road of Parade Ground and from Gate No.1 to Roundabout Shaurya Sthal at Group Centre, CRPF, Kadarapur, Gurugram. Copies of other drawing and documents pertaining to the work will be open for inspection by the tenderers at the office of the DIGP, GC, CRPF, Gurugram (Haryana) -122101. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderers shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials tools and plants. Water, electricity access, and facilities for workers and all

other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by tenderers implies that he has read this notice and all other conditions and rates at which stores, Tools and plants etc., will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having bearing on the execution of the work.

8. The competent authority, on behalf of President of India does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any other tender, and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without the assignment of a reason. All tenderers in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderers shall be summarily rejected.
9. Canvassing, whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the tenderers submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
10. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tendered shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
11. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of one hundred eighty days (180) from the date of opening of tender. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department. Then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the said earnest money as aforesaid.
12. This notice inviting tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful tenderer/contractor, on the acceptance of his tender by the accepting authority, shall within 5 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of: (a) The notice inviting tender, all the documents, including additional conditions specifications and drawings. If any forming the tender as issued at the time of invitation of tender and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
13. Registration: - (a) the contractor should be registered with CPWD/PWD, BRO, RAILWAY or Central/ State Govt.
(b) The contractor should be registered in services tax and GST.
14. The Contractor should give an undertaking that they are bound to complete the work within the stipulated time, in the event of the contractor failing to comply with the above conditions the tender inviting authority shall levy on the contractor, as compensation an amount of equal to 1% (one percent) per week of the total work order value/contract value.
15. All participating contractor must submit an affidavit on non – judicial stamp paper stating that they have neither been **blacklisted nor debarred** from participating in future tenders by any State Govt. / Central Govt. Organizations. If at any stage their claim turns out to be false the said contractor will render itself liable for punitive action, as deemed fit. The present tender in which they have quoted would be summarily rejected besides being debarred from participation in future open tenders for a period of next two consecutive years. Documents mentioned in check list should be uploaded to the respective tender on CPP portal.

16. The Competent authority reserves the right to reject the tender at any stage if any discrepancy or deficiency is found in the tenderprocess.
17. <p>1. Eligibility of Contractor/Firm</p>	<p>Contractors who fulfil the following requirement shall be eligible to apply:</p> <p>1. 9. SITE VISIT AND COLLECTING LOCAL INFORMATION

Before tendering, the tenderer is advised to visit the site, its surroundings to assess and satisfy themselves about the local conditions such as the working and other constraints at site, approach roads to the site, availability of water & power supply, application of taxes, duties and levies as applicable, accommodations they may require etc. & any other relevant information required by them to execute complete scope of work. The tenderer may obtain all necessary information as to risks, weather conditions, contingencies & other circumstances (insurgencies etc.) which may influence or affect their tender prices. Tenderer shall be deemed to have considered site conditions whether he has inspected it or not and to have satisfied himself in all respect before quoting his rates and no claim or extra charges whatsoever in this regard shall be entertained/ payable by the DIG GC CRPF Gurugram at a later date.

10. VALIDITY OF TENDER

The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **180** days from the date of opening of Price Bid of tenders. The earnest money will be forfeited without any prejudice to any right or remedy, in case the contractor withdraws his tender during the validity period or in case he changes his offer to his benefits which are not acceptable to DIG GC, CRPF Gurugram. The validity period may be extended on mutual consent.

11. REJECT/CANCEL/SCRAP

The Competent Authority has the right to accept or reject/cancel/scrap the tender as whole or part of it and no claims what so ever will be entertained on this account. The competent authority also reserves the right to increase/decrease/alter the scope of work/ quantity of work etc. and no claims whatsoever will be entertained.

12. DIRECTION FOR WORKS

All works to be executed under the contract shall be executed under the direction and subject to approval in all respect of the DIG GC, CRPF Gurugram /Engineer-in-Charge of the Work, who shall be entitled to direct at what point or points and in what manner works are to be commenced and executed.

14. DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD

(i) **12 months** from the date of Completion as certified by The -DIG GC, CRPF Gurugram /Officer commanding of Building Branch / Work Committee.

(ii) The contractor shall stand guarantee for materials and workmanship. During the defect liability period, if any defect is observed due to workmanship or from any act or commission of the contractor, the contractor shall execute all such work of rectification and making good of defects, as may be required of him by competent authority at his own cost and within the time stipulated by competent authority. If the contractor shall fail to do any such work as required by the competent authority, Security/Retention money shall be liable to be forfeited and the contractor shall make himself liable to be blacklisted.

14. Payment shall be made to contractor only after giving certificate about satisfactory completion of work. All measurement shall be recorded on **standard measurement Sheet** which will be submitted to The DIG GC, CRPF Gurugram for scrutiny and passing.

15. DIG GC, CRPF Gurugram, Engineer-in-charge shall scrutinize and check the measurement records practically on ground based on the measurement sheet provided by contractor and final measurement sheet will be prepared by Engineer-in-charge.

16. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **within 10 days** from the date of work order.

17. The contractor shall bear cost of **Liquidated Damage** for delay in completion of work within the stipulated time @ of **2%** per month of contracted value not exceeding the 10% of contracted value in whole.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

01. Full name and status of the person signing the tender documents must be clearly mentioned.
02. The firms applying tenders against the subject tender enquiry are informed that all relevant details with reference to the tender enquiry stipulations are clearly responded to. In case any of the tender enquiry stipulations are not clearly stated or replied to by any of the firms, no repeat no clarifications will be sought from the concerned firm and its offer will be rejected out rightly.
03. Catalogues, if any, mentioning the full particulars of the work should be furnished with the quotation.
04. Important information like tender enquiry number, date of tender opening, type of works, full specifications of the works and terms and conditions etc. should be provided wherever required.
05. Tender sample should be produced for inspection and displayed on the date of opening of tender invariably. If the representative of the firm desires to remain present while opening of quotation, the same will be allowed. The samples can also be produced for inspection and display through such representative.
06. Purchaser reserves the right to get the manufacturing capacity of all firms re-verified irrespective of the registration status.
07. Purchaser reserves the right to cancel/reject or scrap any or all the tenders at any stage without assigning any reason.
08. The work order will be placed only after the demonstration/ final inspection and the approval of the sample of the stores by the competent authority.
9. Except as otherwise provided in the invitation to the tender, the contractor hereby declares that the work carries out under this contract shall be of the best quality and workmanship and new in all respects and shall be strictly in accordance with the specification and particulars contained / mentioned in the contract. The contractor hereby guarantees that the said works would continue to conform to the description and quality aforesaid for a period of Eighteen months, from the date of successful completion of work.
10. In the event of contract being cancelled for any breach committed and the purchaser affecting re-painting of the works at the risk and the cost of the contractor, the purchaser is not bound to accept the lower offer of Benami or allied or sister concern of the contractor.
11. Purchaser will not pay separately for transit insurance and the supplier will be responsible till the entire work contracted for, arrive in good condition at the destination. The consignee, as soon as possible but not later than 30 days of the date of arrival of the work at destination, notify to the contractor any loss or damages to the works that may have occurred during the transit.
12. While the purchaser and the tender opener shall make every effort to resolve any issue amicably through direct informal negotiation, in the event of any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the contract shall be settled under the court of law within its jurisdiction at Gurugram. The resultant contract will be interpreted as per the prevailing Indian laws and various directives of the Govt. of India.
