U/C (.) Reg entitlement of tour TA/DA in r/o officers/personnel while they are undergoing course of training away from their Headquarter (.) On the above subject, various references from CRPF formations as well as from PAO CRPF have been received for clarification in details (.) The issue regarding entitlement of tour TA/DA in respect of officials, while they are undergoing course of training away from their Headquarter has been examined in detail with relevant rules and instructions in consultation with FA. It is revealed that:-

- i) As per decision No. 4 below Rule 164 of FR & SR Part-II, while Government Servants deputed to undergo a course/training in India, can be granted travelling allowance / daily allowance, If the period of training does not exceed 180 days in duration and if the pay and allowances of the officer deputed for training have not been increased to meet the expenses of training, he may be allowed travelling allowance at the sliding scales as on tour, viz (i) full DA for 180 days only when boarding and lodging are not provided (ii) First 30 days full DA and next 150 days half DA where boarding and lodging facilities exist;
- ii) Consequent upon the acceptance of the recommendations of the 7th CPC, GOI/MOF vide OM No.19030/1/2017-E-IV dated 13/07/2017 have introduced revised rates of Daily Allowances on Tour consisting of three components viz Hotel Charges, Travelling Charges and Food Bills per day as per pay level in pay Matrix of Central Govt servants subject to production of Bills except food charges bills.
- iii) On implementation of aforesaid OM, there is no logic for reducing the food charges while Central Govt employees are undergoing course/ training due to the reason that concept of single fixed amount of Daily Allowance prior to 7th CPC has been done away by replacing three components viz. Hotel Charges, Travelling Charges and Food Bills per day;

In view of above, it is clarified that while CRPF Officials deputed to undergo training of course, are entitled to draw full rates of food charges during the stay of officials up to maximum 180 days at Training Institutes in accordance with decision No. 4 below Rule 164 of FR & SR Part-II and GOI/MoF OM dated 13/07/2017 (.) However, RHA / Cobra Allowance and Detachment Allowance shall not be admissible simultaneously (.) For PAO only (.)
