Pursuant to the CRPF letter No. U-II-14/2012-13- PROV-CLO dated 12/09/2012, a board of Officers comprising following authorities of CAPFs was assembled in the Conference Hall of Dte. CRPF, New Delhi on 14/9/2012 to finalise QRs/Specification of the Rucksack 30 Ltrs capacity. The technical parameters of the Rucksack are given below :-

1.	Type	Top loader with detachable Pack
2.	Compartments	One bottom compartment, One top compartment with central zip and draw cord and skirting, top lid with pocket & slide compartments.  Provision for carriage of a water bottle of 1 Ltr capacity.
3.	Featuring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Top Compression Strap.</li><li>➤ Side Compression Strap.</li><li>➤ Front Compression Strap.</li><li>➤ Adjustable lid closure.</li><li>➤ Adjustable back system with top and bottom load adjusters.</li><li>➤ Side waist belt adjusters.</li><li>➤ Padded and S shaped shoulder straps with sternum strap</li><li>➤ Padded with curved waist belt.</li><li>➤ Dimensions of pockets – (Right side pocket- 38 x 10 x 9 cms, Front pocket -51x26x9 cms, Main compartment-60x35x23 cms, Upper Left side pocket- 21x10x5cms, Lower left side pocket-17x10x5cms).</li><li>➤ Main compartment divider can be released to create one large compartment.</li><li>➤ Two 25mm Internal Aluminum ( two strips)</li></ul>

4.	Fabrics used	Nylon 6.6 material which is highly abrasive resistant and lighter than web
5.	Webbing	Nylon tapes (Nylon six HT Filament yarn)
6.	Volume (approx)	Minimum 30 litres.
7.	Extras	Attached rain fly with locking loops
