Introduction:-

In the absence of any well defined mechanism earlier there was no option available to the general public through which they could extend financial assistance to the families of *martyrs of the Central Armed Police Forces. When a soldier attains martyrdom, his family faces a very uncertain future, therefore, it is the endeavor of the Government that the family of the martyr is properly taken care of. To ease their mental trauma and to secure them on



social and financial front, the terminal dues to the martyr's family are paid as soon as possible, however this can never make-up for the irreparable human loss suffered by that bareaved family.

Genesis of Bharat Ke Veer:-

With the noble intention of supporting the grieving families, an online portal named "Bharat

Ke Veer" was officially launched on the occasion of "Valour Day" on 09/04/2017 by Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Govt. of India, Through this portal people can contribute financially to express their solidarity with this cause. Basic principle and foundation of BKV is to provide a direct platform between the donors and the NOKs of martyrs so that donors are confident that their contribution is reaching the NOKs. Bharat Ke Veer has two options i.e. "Bravehearts" and "Bharat Ke Veer Corpus Fund".



Inauguration of "Bharat Ke Veer" Portal

(i) Bravehearts:-

Under the option "Bravehearts" any person can donate directly into the bank account of the Next of Kin (NOK) of martyr, as per his ability and



willingness. This donation is directly credited into the bank account of the NOK of Martyr* related to Central Armed Police Forces i.e. Central Reserve Police Force, Border Security Force, Central Industrial Security Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, Sashastra Seema Bal, National Security Guard, Assam Rifles and National Disaster Response Force. The financial assistance collected through this portal goes to NOKs of those martyrs who have attained martyrdom on or after 01/01/2016. By logging in the "Bharat Ke Veer" portal, the photographs of martyrs of Central Armed Police Forces with a brief description of their act of valor in which these personnel have attained martyrdom, is displayed on the screen. All the CAPFs have been provided with the rights to upload details of their Martyrs on the portal. One can donate up to 15 lakhs which is directly credited into the account of NOK of martyr. A limit of Rs. 15 lakh is fixed per martyr, however, if someone wishes to donate more than this ,then he/she will have the option either to choose another martyr or contribute to 'Bharat Ke Veer Corpus'. Once the prescribed limit of Rs.15 lakhs is reached, the details of the martyr uploaded on the "Bharat ke Veer" portal are automatically shifted to "Dashboard", from where the details of the concerned martyr can be viewed anytime. Live status of contribution in account of each martyr is visible on the portal. The domain also facilitates paying homage (Digital Sharadhanjali) to the martyrs.

(ii) Bharat Ke Veer Corpus:-

The other option for donation is "Bharat Ke Veer Corpus" and there is no minimum or maximum prescribed limit for it. To ensure proper and optimum utilization of the available funds, "Bharat Ke Veer Trust" was established. Senior Government Officials of Government of India are the members of this Trust. The main objective of the trust is to implement welfare schemes related to the families of the martyred, injured, retired and serving personnel of the Central Armed Police Forces.

Bharat Ke Veer Trust:-

1.

The Bharat Ke Veer Trust was established on 23rd July'2018, and registered under the Indian Trust Act in the office of Registrar/Sub-Registrar V(1), New Delhi with the following aims and objectives:

To facilitate through a transparent method of

distribution of funds as may be received by the Trust from voluntarily contribution to the corpus of the Trust (BKV corpus) or to the account of NOKs of the martyrs of Central Armed Police Forces/Central Para Military Forces/whose names are uploaded in "Bharat Ke Veer" Portal.

- 2. To support the families of Central Armed Police Forces/Central Para Military Forces Personnel who sacrifice their lives in the service of the Nation, in a manner as may be decided by the Trustees.
- 3. To undertake such other welfare activities for serving /retired CAPF personnel as may be decided by the Trustees. The trustees shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus endowed by the Settlor of the Trust and such other properties (both moveable and immoveable) as acquired from time to time by the Trust, by purchase, exchange, grant, allotment, subscription, endowment, contribution, or in any manner whatsoever(all of which shall be designed as Trust properties) on the Trust herein mentioned.

Office of the Trust is situated at the Head Quarters of Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Block No.1. CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003.

How Does Bharat Ke Veer Trust Work:-

- Donors can voluntarily donate either directly to individual Braveheart's account through BKV portal (upto a maximum of 15 lakhs) or to the Bharat Ke Veer Corpus.
- 2. The amount so accumulated is held as corpus and is then invested as per the manner mentioned under Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act. The Corpus of the Trust along with interest on Bank FDRs/Saving Bank are utilised as under:-
 - To compensate the amount falling short of Rs. 15 Lakhs to the NOKs of martyrs (after 03 months of uploading on BKV portal)
 - ii) To compensate for the amount falling short of Rs. 1 crore (after receiving



various kinds of compensations i.e. Central Ex-Gratia, Home State Ex-Gratia, Duty State Ex-Gratia, General Personal Accident Insurance Scheme, Bank PMSP, Contribution through BKV, other admissible terminal dues paid by the concerned force) after 06 months of uploading on the portal.

- iii) Provide financial assistance of Rs 10 Lakhs to the parent(s) of the martyrs as the total compensation usually goes to the wife of the martyr being the NOK(Next of Kin).
- iv) The Trust has also agreed to pay Rs 10 Lakhs as financial support to those CAPF personnel who are boarded / invalidated out from the service on account of injury/ disability in action while on duty.

Trustees :-

- Union Home Secretary (Settlor of The Trust).
- DG, CRPF (President).
- DG. BSF (Member Trustee).
- DG, AR (Member Trustee).
- IG(ADM), CRPF (Managing Trustee).
- IG (Works), CRPF (Woman Trustee)

Exemption:-

The amount donated through "Bharat ke Veer" Portal is eligible for 50 percent exemption under sub-section 80 (G) of the Income Tax Act,



1961. As Bharat Ke Veer Trust is also registered under section 11(1) of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010, People from abroad can also make contributions by donating to the FCRA account of this fund.

Audit of BKV Account and FCRA Account:-

Since the General Public is donating to Bharat Ke Veer for achieving its noble cause, to maintain transparency among the public, Audit of BKV account and FCRA account is being carried out timely and have been uploaded on BKV portal such that high credibility of the Trust is maintained.

Procedure:-

The process for donation to Bharat Ke Veer portal is as follow: -

- 1. You can donate either online or through cheque/DD.
- 2. For online donation simply visit website "bharatkeveer.gov.in" then go to the option "Contribute".

Two options will be displayed: -

- A. Bravehearts : (To donate to the NOKs of a martyrs)
- B. Bharat Ke Veer Corpus Fund (To donate to the Bharat ke Veer Corpus Fund)

Then follow the process as directed:

3. For contribution by cheque/DD, you have to send through account payee cheque/DD favouring Bharat Ke Veer at the following address:

- 4. Provision for generating online receipt for the donated amount is available.
- 6. It is necessary to enter your mobile number in both the processes, so that the certificate of the donated amount can be issued.



Eligibility criteria:-

The rights to upload details of their Martyrs on BKV portal have been provided to all CAPFs/ AR. A common eligibility criteria has been decided for uploading martyrs details in BKV portal in accordance with the objectives of the trust and cases are to be uploaded preferably within 48 hrs of Martyrdom. Common Eligibility criteria are:

- (a) Deaths where Central Ex-Gratia of Rs. 35 Lakhs is provided.
 - (i) Death occurring in border skirmishes and in action against militants, terrorists, extremists, sea pirates.
- (b) Deaths covered under Category "D" and Category "E" of (Schedule-2) of the Central Civil Services (Extraordinary Pension) Rules.

(Note :: Under category D in sub-para (b) above, only **"on duty"** cases may be considered.

- (c) Deaths while carrying out rescue and relief operations during any man made/natural calamities.
- (d) Personnel on leave who are killed/martyred because of the reason that they belong to security forces.

Extension of Bharat Ke Veer:-

All CAPF personnel who are selflessly rendering duties in high risk/ Corona Hot spots are frontline workers and/or are otherwise equally vulnerable to Covid-19. To provide them financial security in case of any eventuality, it was decided to treat them at par with other health line workers. All such cases of unfortunate deaths of CAPF



personnel due to Covid-19 which are attributable to service, will be uploaded in Bharat Ke Veer Portal by the concerned Force for three months and declare them as "Corona Warriors".

Extension of Bharat Ke Veer under CSR:-

The Bharat Ke Veer trust is registered under CSR with Ministry of Corporate Affairs (CSR No. CSR00019016). Corporate Sector can also contribute for the well being of families of martyrs by contributing to "Bharat Ke Veer" under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).



Financial support to parent(s) of Married Martyrs:-

Earlier there were no provision for providing financial support to the parent(s) of married martyrs. But now parent(s) of married martyrs have been provided with financial assistance of Rs. 10 Lakhs from the Bharat Ke Veer corpus as all admissible compensation usually goes to the wife of married martyr. This provision has been made effective for those married martyrs who have attained martyrdom on or after 01/05/2020.


Financial support to Invalidation out :-

It has been decided by the Board of Trustees that financial assistance of Rs. 10 Lakhs from Bharat Ke Veer corpus will be provided to those CAPF personnel who are boarded / invalidated out from service on account of injury/disability in action while on duty. This will be effective on or after 01/01/2021.




Financial Assistance Provided by Bharat Ke Veer :-


(1) Total NOKs of 367 Martyrs have received financial assistance from Bharat Ke Veer so far.

OPEN SOURCE INTELLIGENCE -SCRAPPING DATA USING TWINT TOOL

Gathering intelligence is a difficult and timeconsuming task. A well-functioning state intelligence system has the ability to change the course of a battle. The importance of intelligence is summed up by a remark from famed Chinese strategist and General Sun-Tzu from the book "Art of War": *"If you know the enemy and know yourself, you need not fear the result of a hundred battles. If you know yourself but not the enemy, for every victory gained you will also suffer a defeat. If you know neither the enemy nor yourself, you will succumb in every battle.*"



Human intelligence (HUMINT), Signals intelligence (SIGINT), Images intelligence (IMINT), Measurement and Signatures intelligence (MASINT), and Open source intelligence are the five approaches for gathering intelligence.In these approaches, open source intelligence is intelligence "extracted from publicly available materials." In the early 20th century, OSINT relied on methods of gathering intelligence from subscribed newspapers, radio or magazines. Compared with other methods, the advantage of open source intelligence is that it is low-risk, low-cost, and usually very effective.OSINT way of gathering information fell out of fashion after World War Two, with intelligence agencies instead focusing on the more glamorous and dangerous world of HUMINT -spying - and SIGINT: signals and electronic intelligence. With the rise of the Internet and social media world, it has regained its reputation for low-cost and efficiency. If we compare it with the 20th century, the platform for intelligence

gathering through the OSINT method has undergone a fundamental change. Today, social media sites such as Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram provide a huge searchable database updated in real time by millions of users. At the same time, collecting information manually can be very time-consuming.

Therefore, automated tools are needed. For twitter data extraction, a tool is available, **Twint**which can crawl through years of twitter data to dig up any information with a single terminal command. It is an advanced scraping tool written in Python that allows for scraping tweets from Twitter profiles without using Twitter's API. Its ability to script and scale twitter searches with Twint makes it a simple but powerful way of extracting data from social media. If we talk about the advantages, then TWINT has the following advantages:

- I. Fast Setup and Easy to use.
- II. Anonymous Scraping and no Twitter Signup needed.

The first question before us is "how to collect meaningful information." Generally speaking, we can achieve this by dividing our task into the following four steps:

We need to ask answerable questions that data can prove or disprove

Then, determining the best source of information to search for the answers.

Analyze the data for hidden clues or patterns, pulling in more data when necessary to build a complete understanding of the target.

Knowledge of the facts of the situation, the

data can be transformed into actionable intelligence to support decision making and a plan of action.

Now we will move on to the more technical parts of using TWINT. The following are guidelines and instructions for LINUX-based operating systems.

STEP-I: Install Twint

pip3 install --upgrade -e git+https://github.com/ twintproject/twint.git@origin/master#egg=twint

STEP-II: Available Filter

If we type twint –h in the terminal Window. We will be able to see (picture (1)) about the options that are available with the tool in order to filter the data of a particular account.

Example I: As an example, suppose our aim is we want to know the Afghan Taliban views/policy on India's internal affair.For this first we will search for the Official Twitter Account Spokesperson related to Taliban which is @Zabehulah. So, after executing the necessary twint command, we were able to find out tweet made on 27 Feb, 2019.

Example II: Another example is about the Kashmir dispute. We all know that on 5 August 2019, the Parliament of India voted in favor of a resolution to revoke the special statusgranted under Article 370 of the Indian Constitution to state of Jammu and Kashmir. Pakistan opposition to this step is not a hidden secret. If we want to analyze the response of Pakistan government in terms of approaching various countries, United Nations ,Human Right Organization and other organization in that matter, then we can analyze the data using the twitter account of Official Pakistan Government i.e. @GovtofPakistan. So, to achieve this aim we will generate a kashmir tweet.txt (or a .csv file) from the handle with the keyword "Kashmir" and mentioning the date as per syntax 2019-06-08. (See Picture (3))

Steps IV: Analyzing the Information

Now, we need to analyze the information. There are many social analytics tools freely available(R Social Analytics tool) which can be further used to analyze the data and provide a meaningful input. R Social Analytics tool is one such open source freely available tool. It can be downloaded from the website link - https://www.rproject.org/. Further, Assessment may be done using the information gathered using other methods to collaborate and prepare the overall intelligence report.

In this article, we looked at the fundamentals of OSINT and how the Twint tool works. There are several other tools that can be used to collect data in a methodical way. Data that is freely and readily available but only awaiting to be delved into. This information can be used to develop useful intelligence reports and aid in our decision-making process about our country's security.



CCIV The positives outweigh the negatives

Privacy is a state in which one is not observed or disturbed by other people, I quote the oxford dictionary here, verbatim. Now if we were to strictly adhere to this definition then privacy automatically becomes a foreign concept as soon as we go out in public. So as to say CCTV's are the ones breaching our privacy does not make sense at all.

Our brain automatically deems the areas where we see the sign 'you are under CCTV surveillance' as unsafe which makes us aware of our surroundings and that forces us to take security measures that we weren't going to. At the same time if a criminal sees that sign he will think at least twice before committing the crime. Let's say he does commit the crime, but then the police will have ample proof to catch him and convict him. Every police investigation starts with checking the surveillance footage of the crime scene, which most of the time provides them with enough leads required to solve the case. CCTV cameras reduced theft and general crime in the UK by 51%, which is a pretty significant number. According to an article published by BBC in London on an average six crimes per day are solved with the help of CCTV's, and mind you this number does not include the crimes that are PREVENTED because of CCTV's. Talking about CCTV cameras, we cannot overlook their contribution in tackling the ongoing pandemic. Tracking the infected to stop the spread of covid-19 was one of the first steps that was taken to flatten the curve and that seems practically impossible to do without the presence of close circuit television camera.

Not a single thing is either good or bad. Everything has its negative aspects, even CCTV cameras about which I've been writing so highly in the past paragraphs. They can be misused, I am not denying that. They also are not the only preventive measure against crimes, they were not meant to replace the already existing safety measures against crimes but to simply aid them, and they seem to be doing a pretty good job so far. They haven't been able to eradicate crime, that's fine but if I say they eventually will then I'll be an imbecile talking about a utopia that doesn't simply exist and never will but at the same time they have been able to reduce crime and I don't see how that could be a bad thing. Anything is good if the positives outweigh the negatives and in the case of CCTV cameras this seems to be the just the case. So in the end all I want to say is that the misuse of CCTV's can be prevented but they are far too helpful for us to not use.

प्रशिक्षण की परिभाषाएं

प्रशिक्षण वह प्रक्रिया है जिसके द्वारा कर्मचारियों की कार्य कुशलता में वृद्धि तथा विकास होता है। प्रशिक्षण एक विशिष्ट ज्ञान है जिसकी आवश्यकता एक कार्य विशेष को करने के लिए होती है। प्रशिक्षण को प्रबन्ध के विभिन्न विद्वानों द्वारा परिभाषित किया गया है। प्रशिक्षण विवर्गीय प्रबन्ध की आधारशिला है। श्रम शक्ति के निर्माण के लिए, उचित भर्ती एवं चुनाव ही पर्याप्त नहीं है, प्रभावी प्रशिक्षण योजना भी आवश्यक है। औद्योगिकीकरण के साथ ही तकनीकी एवं विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में भी तेजी से विकास हुआ है। उत्पादन विधियाँ व प्रक्रियाएँ दिन–प्रतिदिन विशिष्ट एवं जटिल बनती जा रही हैं। अतः श्रमिकों एवं प्रबन्धकों को इन परिवर्तनों के अनुरूप कार्य करना पड़ता है जिसके लिए उन्हें प्रशिक्षण देना आवश्यक हो जाता है। प्रशिक्षण केवल नए कर्मचारियों के लिए ही नहीं बल्कि पुराने कर्मचारियों के लिए भी आवश्यक है।

विवर्गीय प्रबन्धक सभी विभागों के कर्मचारियों के लिए प्रशिक्षण की व्यवस्था करता है। प्रशिक्षण एक ऐसी प्रक्रिया है जो निरन्तर चलती रहती है। कर्मचारी प्रशिक्षण वास्तव में मानवीय संसाधन विकास का एक भाग है तथा यह मानवीय संसाधन प्रबन्ध का एक क्रियात्मक कार्य है।

सभी संस्थाओं को विभिन्न कार्यों के लिए प्रशिक्षित एवं अनुभवी कर्मचारियों की आवश्यकता होती है। यदि कर्मचारी का ज्ञान एवं कौशल वर्तमान जॉब की आवश्यकताओं के अनुरूप है तो प्रशिक्षण की आवश्यकता नहीं है। परन्तु यदि ऐसा नहीं है तो ज्ञान एवं कौशल में वृद्धि की आवश्यकता है। इसके अतिरिक्त कार्य की जटिलता के बढ़ने से प्रशिक्षण की आवश्यकता भी बढ़ जाती है। प्रशिक्षण का उद्देश्य कर्मचारियों को पर्याप्त मार्ग–दर्शन व निर्देश देना है जिससे वे अपने कार्य को कुशलता से पूरा कर सके। प्रशिक्षण से कर्मचारियों की कार्य कुशलता में वृद्धि तथा विकास होता है।

एक विधिवत प्रशिक्षण योजना, कार्य में गुणात्मक एवं परिमाणात्मक सुधार करती है, मशीनों को सुरक्षित रखती है, लागत कम करती है, कर्मचारियों की आय तथा उनके मनोबल में वृद्धि करती है तथा कम्पनी की नीतियों को प्रभावी ढंग से लागू करवाती है। साधारण शब्दों में, कर्मचारी को एक विशेष कार्य करने के लिए योग्यता प्रदान करना ही प्रशिक्षण है। इस प्रकार किसी विशिष्ट कार्य को विशेष ढंग से निष्पादित/सम्मान करने की कला, ज्ञान एवं कौशल ही प्रशिक्षण है। संगठन के सभी स्तरों पर कर्मचारियों के कार्य की गुणवत्ता में सुधार करने के लिए, प्रशिक्षण एवं विकास कार्यक्रमों की आवश्यकता है।

प्रशिक्षण नीति

प्रशिक्षण की व्यवस्था करना विवर्गीय विभाग का उत्तरदायित्व है। उचित प्रशिक्षण नीति उच्च प्रबन्धकों (Top Management) द्वारा तय की जाती है। इसका निर्धारण संस्था के प्रशिक्षण उद्देश्यों को ध्यान में रखकर

महिला कर्मचारियों को प्रशिक्षित करने एवं उन्हें प्रशिक्षण के समान अवसर प्रदान करने के उद्देश्य से रोजगार तथा प्रशिक्षण महानिदेशालय ने 1977 में महिलाओं के लिए व्यावसायिक प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम प्रारम्भ किया। इस कार्यक्रम के अन्तर्गत, महिलाओं के प्रशिक्षण के लिए एक "महिलाओं के लिए राष्ट्रीय व्यावसायिक प्रशिक्षण संस्थान" की स्थापना नोएडा में की गई है।

किया जाना चाहिए। प्रशिक्षण एक निरन्तर चलने वाली प्रक्रिया है इसमें काफी समय व धन का व्यय होता है। अतः यह आवश्यक है कि प्रशिक्षण प्रोग्राम का आयोजन काफी सोच–विचार कर किया जाए।

प्रशिक्षण प्रोग्राम, संस्था एवं प्रशिक्षणार्थी की आवश्यकताओं को ध्यान में रखकर बनाना चाहिए। एक सफल प्रशिक्षण प्रोग्राम में प्रशिक्षण के महत्त्वपूर्ण क्षेत्रों का चुनाव सावधानी पूर्वक किया जाना चाहिए। प्रशिक्षण के लिए उचित वातावरण होना भी आवश्यक है।

अभिप्रेरण का सिद्धान्त

प्रशिक्षण को प्रभाव पर्ण बनाने के लिए यह आवश्यक है कि वह प्रशिक्षणार्थियों को प्रशिक्षण प्राप्त करने के लिए अभिप्रेरित कर सके। प्रशिक्षणार्थी को यह पता होना चाहिए कि प्रशिक्षण से उसकी कौन सी आवश्यकताओं की पूर्ति होगी, जिससे वह पूरी लगन से प्रशिक्षण प्राप्त करें। जब प्रशिक्षणार्थी यह समझते हैं कि प्रशिक्षण से उन्हें अधिक आय, प्रशंसा

या पदोन्नति मिलेगी तो वे ज्यादा रुचि से प्रशिक्षण प्राप्त करेंगे।

अभ्यास का सिद्धान्त

यह सिद्धान्त कार्य कुशलता में वृद्धि के लिए अभ्यास एवं पुनरावृत्ति (Repetition) पर जोर देता है। प्रशिक्षण को प्रभावी बनाने के लिए यह आवश्यक है प्रशिक्षणार्थियों (Trainee) से पूरा अभ्यास कराया जाए। इसके अतिरिक्त, महिलाओं के लिए क्षेत्रीय व्यावसायिक प्रशिक्षण केन्द्रों की भी स्थापना की गई है। इन क्षेत्रीय प्रशिक्षण केन्द्रों की संख्या 10 है। केरल में एक और क्षेत्रीय प्रशिक्षण केन्द्र को अनुमति दे दी गई है।

इस कार्यक्रम का देश के सभी जिलों में विस्तार किया गया है। इस योजना का उद्देश्य महिलाओं का आय–स्तर बढ़ाना एवं

उनका सामाजिक विकास करना है। राज्य स्तर पर भी महिलाओं को व्यावसायिक प्रशिक्षण देने के लिए 438 औद्योगिक प्रशिक्षण संस्थाओं (महिला विंग) की स्थापना की गई है। महिलाओं के प्रशिक्षण के लिए नियमित प्रशिक्षण के अतिरिक्त अल्प—अवधि प्रशिक्षण भी विभिन्न संस्थाओं द्वारा आयोजित किए जाते हैं।


ग शब्द संस्कृत की युज धातु से बना है जिसका अर्थ जुड़ना या एकजुट होना या शामिल होना है। योग सुक्ष्म विज्ञान पर आधारित एक आध्यात्मिक विषय है जो मन एवं शरीर के बीच सामंजस्य स्थापित करने पर ध्यान देता है। आधुनिक वैज्ञानिकों के अनुसार ब्रह्मांड की हर चीज उसी परिमाण नभ की अभिव्यक्ति मात्र है। जो भी अस्तित्व की इस एकता को महसूस कर लेता है उसे योग में स्थित कहा जाता है और उसे योगी के रूप में पुकारा जाता है जिसने मुक्त अवस्था प्राप्त कर ली है, जिसे मुक्ति, निर्वाण या मोक्ष कहा जाता है। यह स्वस्थ जीवन-यापन की कला एवं विज्ञान है। योग से जुड़े ग्रंथों के अनुसार योग करने से व्यक्ति की चेतना ब्रह्मांड की चेतना से जुड़ जाती है जो मन एवं शरीर, मानव एवं प्रकृति के बीच परिपूर्ण सामंजस्य का द्योतक है। इस प्रकार, योग का लक्ष्य आत्म-अनुभूति, सभी प्रकार के कष्टों से निजात पाना है जिससे मोक्ष की अवस्था या कैवल्य की अवस्था प्राप्त होती है।

कई हजार वर्ष पहले, हिमालय में कांति सरोवर झील के तटों पर आदि योगी ने अपने प्रबुद्ध ज्ञान को अपने प्रसिद्ध सप्तऋषि को प्रदान किया था। सत्पऋषियों ने योग के इस ताकतवर विज्ञान को एशिया, मध्य पूर्व, उत्तरी अफ्रीका एवं दक्षिण अमरीका सहित विश्व के भिन्न–भिन्न भागों में पहुंचाया। रोचक बात यह है कि आधुनिक विद्वानों ने पूरी दुनिया में प्राचीन संस्कृतियों के बीच पाए गए घनिष्ठ समानांतर को नोट किया है। तथापि, भारत में ही योग ने अपनी सबसे पूर्ण अभिव्यक्ति प्राप्त की। ऐसा माना जाता है कि जब से सभ्यता शुरू हुई है तभी से योग किया जा रहा है। योग के विज्ञान की उत्पत्ति हजारों साल पहले हुई थी, पहले धर्मों या आस्था के जन्म लेने से काफी पहले हुई थी। योग विद्या में शिव को पहले योगी या आदि योगी तथा पहले गुरू या आदि गुरू के रूप में माना जाता है। अगस्त नामक सप्तऋषि, जिन्होंने पूरे भारतीय उप महाद्वीप का दौरा किया, ने यौगिक तरीके से जीवन जीने के इर्द–गिर्द इस संस्कृति को गढ़ा।

योग करते हुए पित्रों के साथ सिंधु-सरस्वती घाटी सभ्यता के अनेक जीवाश्म अवशेष एवं मुहरें भारत में योग की मौजूदगी का संकेत व सुझाव देती हैं। देवी मां की मूर्तियों की मुहरें, लैंगिक प्रतीक तंत्र योग का सुझाव देते हैं। लोक परंपराओं, सिंधु घाटी सभ्यता, वैदिक एवं उपनिषद की विरासत, बौद्ध एवं जैन परंपराओं, महाभारत एवं रामायण जैसे महाकाव्यों, शैवों, वैष्णवों की आस्तिक परंपराओं एवं तांत्रिक परंपराओं में योग की मौजूदगी है। इसके अलावा, वैदिक काल के दौरान सूर्य को सबसे अधिक महत्व दिया गया।







योगदान दिया। हठयोग परंपरा के नाथ योगी जैसे कि मत्स्येंद्र नाथ, गोरख नाथ, गौरांगी नाथ, स्वात्माराम सूरी, घेरांडा, श्रीनिवास भट्ट ऐसी कुछ महान हस्तियां हैं जिन्होंने इस अवधि के दौरान हठ योग की परंपरा को लोकप्रिय बनाया।

1700 ईसवी— 1900 ईसवी के बीच की अवधि को आधुनिक काल के रूप में माना जाता है जिसमें महान योगाचार्यों— रमन महर्षि, रामकृष्ण परमहंस, परमहंस योगानंद, विवेकानंद आदि ने राज योग के विकास में योगदान दिया है। यह ऐसी अवधि है जिसमें वेदांत, भक्ति योग, नाथ योग या हठ योग फला—फूला। शादंगा—गोरक्ष शतकम का योग, चतुरंगा—हठयोग प्रदीपिका का योग, सप्तंगा—घेरांडा संहिता का योग—हठ योग के मुख्य जड़सूत्र थे।

आजकल पूरी दुनिया में योग साधना से लाखों व्यक्तियों को लाभ हो रहा है, जिसे प्राचीन काल से लेकर आजतक योग के महान आचार्यों द्वारा परिरक्षित किया गया है। योग साधना का हर दिन विकास हो रहा है तथा यह अधिक जीवंत होती जा रही है।

500 ईसा पूर्व– 800 ईस्वी सन के बीच की अवधि को श्रेष्ठ अवधि के रूप में माना जाता है जिसे योग के इतिहास एवं विकास में सबसे उर्वर एवं महत्वपूर्ण अवधि के रूप में भी माना जाता है। इस अवधि के दौरान, योग सूत्रों एवं भागवद्गीता आदि पर व्यास के टीकाएं अस्तित्व में आईं। इस अवधि को मुख्य रूप से भारत के दो महान धार्मिक उपदेशकों–महावीर एवं बुद्ध को समर्पित किया जा सकता है। महावीर द्वारा पांच महान व्रतों–पंच महाव्रतों एवं बुद्ध द्वारा अष्ठ मग्गा या आठ पथ की संकल्पना–को योग साधना की शुरूआती प्रकृति के रूप में माना जा सकता है। हमें भागवद्गीता में इसका अधिक स्पष्ट स्पष्टीकरण प्राप्त होता है जिसमें ज्ञान योग, भक्ति योग और कर्म योग

की संकल्पना को विस्तार से प्रस्तुत किया गया है।
