Sh. J M Vyas, Director General Gujarat Forensic Science University, in his Opening Address briefly touched upon the perpetration of crime, crime investigation and advancement of modern technology in forensic science.

Dr. Vyas emphasized that the original nature of mind is happiness and everybody pursues the objects of happiness. Whereas everybody undertakes activities of his choice for gaining happiness and remaining happy, a few take to such activities which are otherwise not novel for the general society. Such people have perverted minds and they find happiness only in socially unacceptable things like a thief seeks happiness in stealing, an addict seeks happiness in drugs, a murderer seeks happiness in murder etc. Obtaining the object of happiness through unjust means is crime and the crime investigation uses the principles of happiness and uniqueness. Everybody is unique in body constitution. The eye brows, the teeth, the ears, the hair etc. of any person are unique and do not match with those of anybody else.

Dr. Vyas emphasized the need to keep updated in knowledge, skills and expertise not only in the field of crime investigation, but in every sphere of life. It is the sole purpose of training to keep updated and refreshed in knowledge and skills to cope up with the advancing technologies of the world.

In the field of forensic science, the chief guest discussed about Drone Forensics. He told the participants that the Drone Forensics is a branch of digital forensics relating to recovery of digital evidence or data from a drone. The phrase drone forensics (UAV) usually refers to frones, however, it can also relate to any wireless remote controlled UAV that has both internal memory and communication ability, including Cameras, WiFi, GPS and 3G or 4G connectivity.

Dr. J.M Vyas encouraged the participant officers to keep themselves up-to-date in knowledge, skills and expertise through continuous training, reading books, experience sharing and continuously remaining aware about any changes in the technology or other spheres of knowledge.

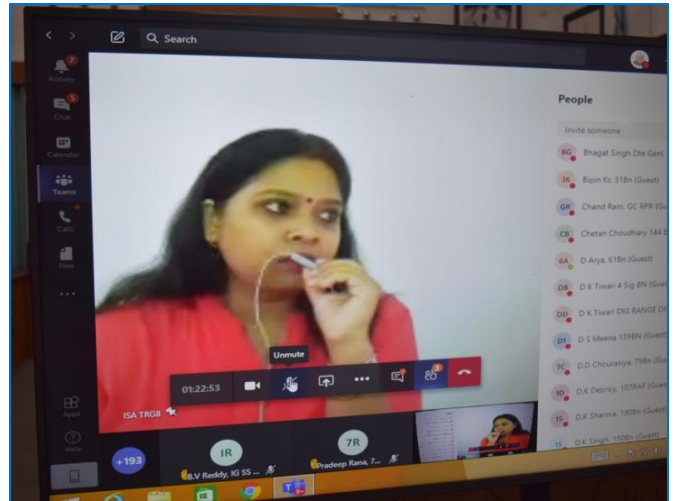

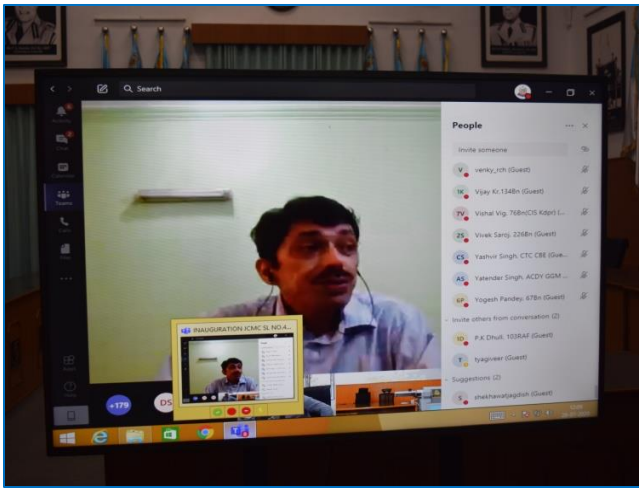

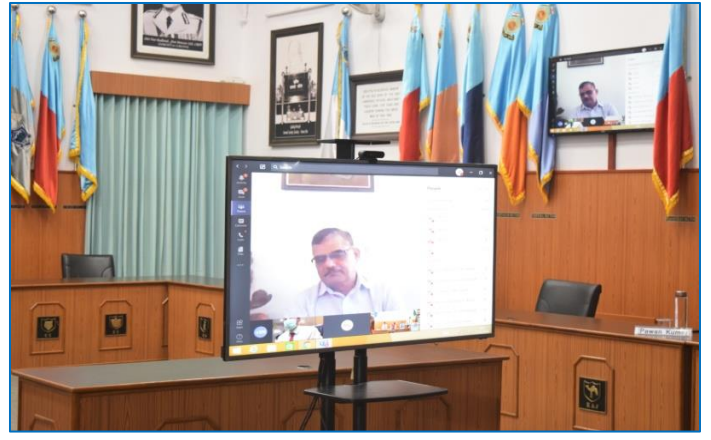
